Today, we celebrate the Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time. We are presented with the time when Jesus sent out seventy-two others ahead of him "in pairs to every town and place He

intended to visit.," (Luke 10:1). They were to say that the kingdom of God was at hand for them. That's a message for us today as well. We are reminded of our reliance on God. 
#### Mission Appeal Weekend Please welcome Fr. Paul Mutuku Nzuva presenting on behalf of the Diocese of Machakos, Kenya.

The Diocese of Machakos is one of the largest in Kenya with 83 parishes and over 1,200 outstations. The total population is about 2.8 million of which about 1.2 million are baptized Catholics. The Diocese lies in a semi-arid area where the annual rainfall is low and unreliable. Drought, famine & poverty are challenges faced by much of the population, since they depend on agriculture for their livelihood. This year is providing additional challenges with the effects of the pandemic and a scourge of locusts which destroyed many crops.



In Kenya, improving the lives of the people is usually accomplished through the efforts of the Church rather than the Government. Thanks in large part to the prayers and support of Catholics in the United States, the Diocese of Machakos is making a positive difference in the lives of the people by operating 2 hospitals and over 20 clinics/dispensaries; maintaining 4 orphanages; maintaining 21 group homes for disabled children; building and maintaining a primary school for orphans and other needy children; drilling of wells and providing education on proper land usage; organizing workshops on health and nutrition issues; etc.

Donations received will be used to complete construction of the Uganda Martyrs School for orphans and other needy children, support and maintain the hospitals, orphanages and group homes. In addition, the Diocese plans to complete construction and maintenance of a vocational training center for the physically challenged; provide

#### From the Office of the Pastor of Divine Mercy Parish Reverend Father Robert T. Cooper

#### **OVERTURNING ROE V. WADE**

Dear Brothers and Sisters in the Lord:

The United States Supreme Court finally issued its ruling in Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization today, upholding Mississippi's 15-week abortion ban, overturning Roe v. Wade on a 6-3 vote, and delivering the pro-life cause its most transformative victory since Roe unleashed nationwide abortion-on-demand in 1973. Justice Samuel Alito delivered the opinion of the Court, which was joined by Chief Justice John Robert and Associate Justices Clarence Thomas, Neil Gorsuch, Brett Kavanaugh, and Amy Coney Barret. The ruling declares Roe "egregiously wrong from the start."

"Its reasoning was exceptionally weak, and the decision has had damaging consequences," Alito wrote. "It is time to heed the Constitution and return the issue of abortion to the people's elected representatives."

For us who are pro-life, the overturning of Roe v. Wade is an answer to prayer, the correction of a Supreme Court decision 49 years ago that failed to protect the most basic human right, the right to life. In 1973, the U.S. bishops called the Roe v. Wade decision "erroneous, unjust, and immoral." It was a tragic and sweeping decision which denied the child in the womb the right to life and led to the deaths of millions of unborn children in our nation. The Roe v. Wade decision has also led to the further erosion of the value of human life, even the allowance for partial-birth abortion, near infanticide, as well as a diminishment of respect for the lives of other vulnerable people, including the disabled and the terminally ill, as seen in euthanasia and assisted suicide.

While we weep for the 63 million precious lives that were lost the past 49 years, we rejoice alongside every witness in heaven over the victory that transpired today for the unborn. We also give thanks to the Lord that our nation's justices were able to stand strong despite tremendous pressure and threats of personal peril as they overturned the evil that was Roe v. Wade. Though there is still more work ahead to continue the fight, we pause to recognize the magnitude of this decision — and give all glory to God for this victory.

Though we celebrate the reversal of Roe v. Wade, such a reversal will not end abortion in our nation — it pushes the battle back to the states. Permissive abortion laws will continue or increase in many states. We will need to continue to advocate for legislation to protect the unborn and to help their mothers. And we will need to continue to work for the evangelization of our culture since in many ways since Roe v. Wade, what St. John Paul II called "a culture of death" has grown and spread. We evangelize by proclaiming, living, and serving the Gospel of Jesus Christ, the Gospel of life, the Gospel of love and mercy. We serve the good of society when we teach and educate and form consciences about the dignity of every human person, at every moment and in every condition. We serve the Gospel of life when, motivated by love, we care for the poor, the marginalized, migrants and refugees, the elderly, the suffering, and all who need assistance. We must continue to stand ready to assist and accompany any woman or couple facing unexpected or difficult pregnancies.

I hope and pray that the Supreme Court decision overturning Roe v. Wade will mark a new beginning in our nation. In the short term, it will undoubtedly elicit angry protests. I pray that, in the long term, it will help to awaken the conscience of our nation to the sacredness of all human life. May the Lord strengthen us in our commitment to the Gospel of life! May He bless our nation with a new culture of love and solidarity, a culture that respects the dignity of every human person from the moment of conception until natural death!



### **HISPANIC MINISTRY**

La Diócesis de Machakos es una de las más grandes de Kenia con 83 parroquias y más de 1200 estaciones remotas. La población total es de unos 2,8 millones, de los cuales unos 1,2 millones son católicos bautizados. La Diócesis se encuentra en una zona semiárida donde la precipitación anual es escasa y poco fiable. La sequía, el hambre y la pobreza son desafíos que enfrenta gran parte de la población, ya que dependen de la agricultura para su sustento. Este año presenta desafíos adicionales con los efectos de la pandemia y un flagelo de langostas que destruyó muchos cultivos.

En Kenia, mejorar la vida de las personas generalmente se logra a través de los esfuerzos de la Iglesia en lugar del Gobierno. Gracias en gran parte a las oraciones y el apoyo de los católicos en los Estados Unidos, la Diócesis de Machakos está marcando una diferencia positiva en la vida de las personas al operar 2 hospitales y más de 20 clínicas/dispensarios; mantenimiento de 4 orfanatos; mantenimiento de 21 hogares grupales para niños discapacitados; edificio y mantener una escuela primaria para huérfanos y otros niños necesitados; perforación de pozos y educación sobre el uso adecuado de la tierra; organizar talleres sobre temas de salud y nutrición; etc.

Las donaciones recibidas se utilizarán para completar la construcción de la Escuela de Mártires de Uganda para huérfanos y otros niños necesitados, apoyar y mantener los hospitales, orfanatos y hogares grupales. Además, la Diócesis planea completar la construcción y el mantenimiento de un centro de formación profesional para discapacitados físicos; proveer apoyo a la adopción de métodos agrícolas más eficientes y sostenibles;

hacer pagos de matrículas escolares para huérfanos y niños de familias pobres; compra de autos y motos para uso en trabajo pastoral en estaciones y áreas remotas.

#### FR. COOPER'S CORNER

#### Religious Liberty

It is the Fourth of July weekend, a time to reflect on liberty and freedom. Many today have concerns that their freedom is being eroded by increasing and over-reaching governmental intrusion. And, while as Catholics steeped in the moral vision of the Scriptures and Tradition we seek to balance individual rights and the common good, we do rightly have concerns that one of our most fundamental rights recognized in the First Amendment is being threatened by an unprecedented mandate that we violate our consciences and surrender our religious liberty simply because the government demands it.

Note the language that the First Amendment "recognizes" our freedom to freely exercise our religion. For the State does not grant us this right, God does. It is among those rights the Declaration of Independence so nobly calls "unalienable" rights and says are endowed by our Creator. Hence, in no way can our right to religious freedom be abridged simply because a president, a congress, or a director of a government agency says so. They did not give us this liberty, and they cannot take it away. We will not and cannot cede to man, what God has given.

And mind you, the recent Covid-19 mandates were only the latest and boldest move of what has been a steady stream of threats eroding our religious liberty. These issues affect not only Catholics, but people of many religious backgrounds. However, the Catholic Church is particularly targeted and threatened because we have stood so vocally and firmly in opposition to many aspects of the cultural revolution in America such as abortion, embryonic stem cell research, euthanasia, the increasing "genocide" against the disabled via selective abortion and pernicious prenatal screening, gay "marriage," and so forth.

As the wider American culture continues to move away from Biblical teachings and Natural Law norms, our Catholic adherence to this age-old wisdom has come to be seen by many as obnoxious, and we are considered to be an influence which must be strongly withstood. Rather than understand our concerns as a principled stance rooted in Biblical norms that we cannot simply set aside, many, in the wider culture, have chosen to describe our stance as bigoted, reactionary, hateful, and broadly intolerant. As such, many see the repudiation of our religious rights and liberty as "righteous" and as a vindication of their cultural agenda. But the rejoicing in some circles and the active attempt by some to suppress our religious liberty is short-sighted. For, if the government can deny the liberty of one group, all groups are threatened. If the government can attempt to legally force a large segment of the US population to act contrary to their conscience, no other segment is safe either.

The threat to religious liberty is both real and growing. For if the government can seek to compel in these matters offensive to long-standing Catholic teaching, it can just as easily come after what others consider sacred and right. Do not be deceived, this is about a serious threat to the First Amendment and to the religious liberty of all, not just Catholics, and not just the various churches, but against you, as an individual citizen as well. It is not just the Church that has religious liberty, YOU have religious liberty and no government or official has the right to prohibit the free exercise of your religious duties.



Do not allow others to describe the First Amendment merely as the "freedom of worship." It is far more. It is to be able to freely exercise one's religion. You are not a Catholic merely inside the church building. You are a Catholic at the supermarket, at the job, in the political arena, in the influence of public policy, and in the daily discourse that seeks to influence the thinking and behavior of your fellow citizens. We, as believers, have the same rights as any other citizens or groups to advocate and organize for causes and courses of action we see as helpful to this country. An essential part of the free exercise of our religious duty is to evangelize the culture and everyone who will listen. It is unacceptable to speak of religious liberty as merely the freedom to worship inside a Church building; it is far more.

The extreme secularists presume they can simply wear us down by their repeated and numerous legal maneuverings. And, frankly, they may be right, unless people like you and I are vigilant and unflinching in supporting the Church as she battles these attacks. And don't be too sanguine about how we should be willing to endure persecution. We should endure and persevere, but that does not mean we simply surrender our Constitutional rights at the door and let secularists and proponents of the cultural revolution isolate us. We have every Constitutional right that any American does, and we cannot simply let the Church be silenced by either ignoring the problem or minimizing it. There is an important Battle underway. Where do you stand? What will you do? To quote Martin Luther King Jr., "My daddy always said, 'If you find a good fight, get in it." Well, this is a good fight, a necessary fight. Get in it!
