



Today, we celebrate the Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time. We are presented with the story of the Canaanite woman's faith when Jesus was in the region of Tyre and Sidon. She desired healing for her daughter that was

tormented by a demon. In the Gospel (MT 15:21-28), the Canaanite woman called out to Jesus, "Have pity on me, Lord, Son of David," (MT 15:22). As Fr. Conley Bertrand reminds us in Understanding the Sunday Gospels- Gospel Commentaries for Cycle A, "Most of the inhabitants of the district of Tyre and Sidon are pagans." He further tells us that "the Canaanites, you may remember, are a sinful race in the Old Testament.' But, be at peace, God is merciful! At the end of this Gospel story, "the woman's daughter was healed," (MT 15:22). This can be a reminder of how "everyone" can receive God's mercy. A Lifeteen author reminds us that "All are invited to pray and rejoice in God our savior." The author further says that "God is all merciful to those who repent from their disobedience." That message may fill us with joy and help one to comprehend part of God's mercy. The mercy of Christ is further addressed by the USCCB's mission, which is to encounter the mercy of Christ and to accompany His people with joy. In the diary of St. Faustina, she said, "Proclaim that mercy is the greatest attribute of God. All the works of My hands are crowned with mercy," On Sunday nights, Divine Mercy Youth discusses the mercy of God and ways "we can do what is right, observe what is just, and be obedient to (God's) commandments" (from a Lifeteen prayer/author) with our family and friends in our homes, schools, workplaces, communities, society, and the world. We also talk about many other teachings of Jesus as well as Reconciliation. In addition, we also talk about topics regarding Our Blessed Mother and how she leads us to her Son. Under the protection of Mary's mantle, you are invited to join us!

Divine Mercy Youth is a high school ministry for all 8th through 12th grade students. Our aim is to help teens grow in intentional discipleship through prayer, community, and formation. Divine Mercy Youth is held on Sunday Nights following the 5pm mass and will serve as the catechetical program for all students who are not in catholic school. The Second Collection This Weekend is for the Mission Appeal for the Diocese of Same, Tanzania

Message to Divine Mercy Church:

Tanzania is one of the poorest countries in the World, with 80% of the population practicing rural subsistence farming. Tanzania has a population of 57 million people, 15 million of whom live in absolute poverty, earning less than \$1.00 a day. The standard of living of the people in the Diocese of Same is below that of most Tanzanians.

One of the serious problems facing the people of Same is poor health. In Ruvu village, where I have the parish, people walk on foot for more

than thirty miles to reach a medical clinic. Due to the lack of clinics in the village, many newborn babies, children, and women, die from Malaria, respiration infections, pregnancy complications, and diarrhea.

One day on Sunday as I was celebrating mass, a lady at the back of the church raised her hand up and cried out that her daughter is sick, and she is dying, she wanted me to take her daughter to the hospital. I told her that after mass I will take her daughter to the hospital. In that village, there are no cars, schools, shopping centers, or hospitals. So, many children and pregnant women die from complications of pregnancy.


After I told my bishop about this true story, my bishop said, I think God is calling us to purchase an ambulance for these poor people of Ruvu village. Then, my bishop wrote to your archbishop and your archbishop gave us this wonderful parish of Divine Mercy to come and ask you for a donation to help us to purchase an ambulance to help these women and children to have access to the hospital.

So, I am here to ask you for a donation to purchase an ambulance for the poor women and children in the Diocese of Same, Tanzania.



Tanzania es uno de los países más pobres del mundo, con el 80% de la población practicando la agricultura rural de subsistencia. Tanzania tiene una población de 57 millones de personas, 15 millones de las cuales viven en la pobreza absoluta y ganan menos de \$1.00 por día. El nivel de vida de la gente de la diócesis de Same está por debajo del de la mayoría de los tanzanos.

Uno de los graves problemas a los que se enfrenta la población de Same es la mala salud. En el pueblo de Ruvu, donde tengo la parroquia, la gente camina a pie más de treinta millas para llegar a una clínica médica. Debido a la falta de clínicas en el pueblo, muchos bebés recién nacidos, niños y mujeres mueren de malaria, infecciones respiratorias, complicaciones del embarazo y diarrea.

Un día domingo mientras estaba celebrando misa, una señora al fondo de la iglesia levantó la mano y gritó que su hija está enferma, y se está muriendo, quería que la llevara al hospital. Le dije que después de misa llevaré a su hija al hospital. En ese pueblo no hay carros, escuelas, centros comerciales, ni hospitales. Entonces, muchos niños y mujeres embarazadas mueren por complicaciones del embarazo.

Después de que le conté a mi obispo sobre esta historia real, mi obispo dijo: Creo que Dios nos está llamando a comprar una ambulancia para esta pobre gente del pueblo de Ruvu. Entonces, mi obispo le




