## Quality Time

For over 10 years, we have been blessed to have **Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration** here at Divine Parish. Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration is the adoration of Jesus Christ present in the Holy Eucharist. The Eucharist is displayed in a special holder called a monstrance, and **people come to pray and worship Jesus continually throughout the day and the night for 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.**

**Come to our Perpetual Adoration Chapel** and spend some time with our Lord. He is waiting there to embrace you, lovingly and mercifully! You may bring your own prayer books (or use the books in the bookcase), pray the Rosary, pray the Psalms or the Liturgy of the Hours, and meditate using Scriptures. You are coming to visit your best friend, pour your heart out! Tell Him about your joys and worries, thank Him, ask for guidance and strength, ask for forgiveness and intercede for others or just sit in silence and enjoy the sweet peace that comes from simply being in the Presence of God! ## ST. BLAISE BLESSING OF THE THROATS

SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 3  
AFTER THE 8:30 AM & 4 PM MASSES  
AND SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 4  
AFTER ALL MASSES



Catholics often participate in the tradition of having their throats blessed. To do this, the priest consecrates two candles, generally by a prayer, and then holds each in a crossed position on the throat of the person being blessed. At the same time, the following blessing is given: *"Through the intercession of Saint Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from ailments of the throat and from every other evil. In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen."*

Why does the blessing of the throat take place on St. Blaise Day? St. Blaise, a physician and bishop, asked God to cure a child who was choking to death on a fish bone and the child's life was saved. Thus, St. Blaise is the patron saint of healthy throats.

The **Blessing of Throats** will take place at Divine Mercy Parish **following the First Saturday Devotions** (begins with Confession at 7:30am) and **after all weekend Masses on February 3rd and 4th.**



