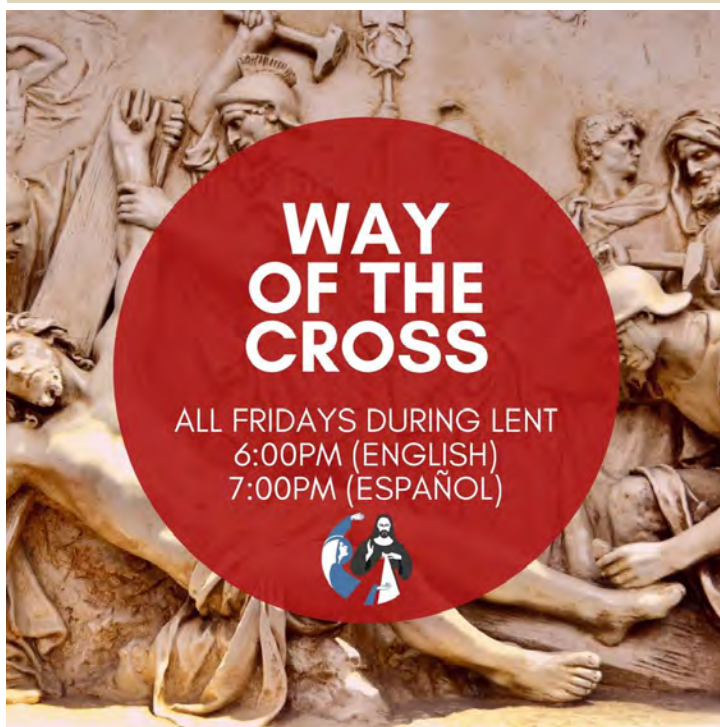
### FASTING AND ABSTINENCE

Fasting is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59. Those who are bound to fast may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to each one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

Abstinence from meat is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years or older on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and on all Fridays of Lent. The determination of certain days as obligatory days of penance should not be understood as limiting the occasions for Christian penance.

### MAINTAINING THE SPIRIT OF THE SEASON OF LENT

The Spirit of the season of Lent should be maintained throughout the weeks of Lent. The obligation to observe penitential days of the Church is a very important part of our spiritual life. Individual circumstances must be taken into account, but in general, people should seek to do more rather than less, since fast and abstinence on the days prescribed should be considered a minimal response to the Lord's call to penance and conversion of life.

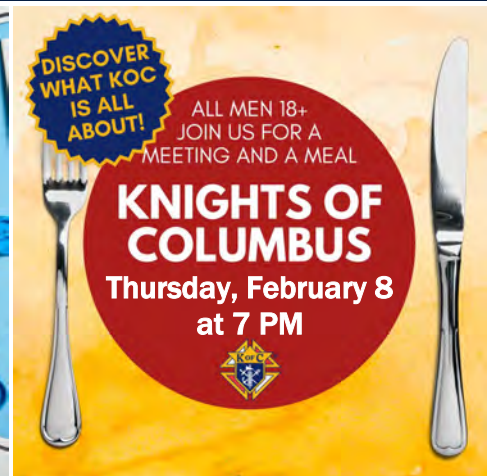
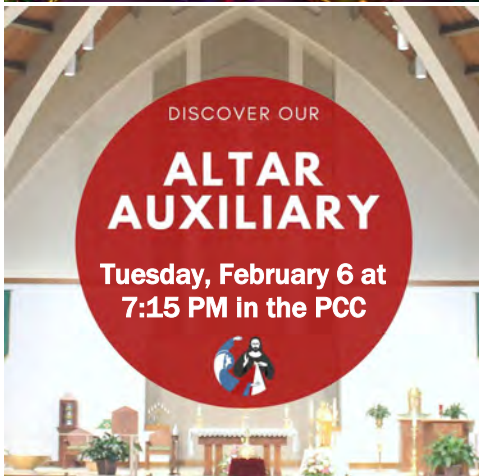

# CUARESMA

## EN LA PARROQUIA DIVINA MISERICORDIA

### AYUNO Y ABSTINENCIA

El ayuno debe ser observado el Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo por todos los católicos que tengan 18 años de edad, pero aun no hayan cumplido los 59. Aquellos que están obligados a ayunar pueden tomar solo una comida completa. Se permiten dos comidas más pequeñas si es necesario para mantener la fuerza de acuerdo con las necesidades de cada uno, pero no se permite comer alimentos sólidos entre comidas.

Todos los católicos mayores de 14 años deben observar la abstinencia de carne el Miércoles de Ceniza, el Viernes Santo y todos los viernes de Cuaresma. La determinación de ciertos días como días obligatorios de penitencia no debe entenderse como una limitación de las ocasiones para la penitencia cristiana.

### MANTENER EL ESPÍRITU DEL TIEMPO DE CUARESMA

El Espíritu de la temporada de Cuaresma debe mantenerse a lo largo de las semanas de Cuaresma. La obligación de observar los días de penitencia de la Iglesia es una parte muy importante de nuestra vida espiritual. Deben tenerse en cuenta las circunstancias individuales, pero en general, las personas deben buscar hacer más que hacer menos, ya que el ayuno y la abstinencia en los días prescritos deben considerarse una respuesta mínima al llamado del Señor a la penitencia y conversión de vida.
