What is A Vocations Chalice?

The purpose of the **Chalice Program** is to encourage families to **pray and promote vocations to the Priesthood and Religious Life**. The consecrated Chalice is a tangible reminder of this special intention for the Church. The Second Vatican Council highlights the responsibility of the laity to pray for and support vocations. This urgent call has been strongly affirmed in the writings and addresses of both Pope John Paul II and Pope Benedict XVI.

Praying for vocations is the most powerful way to support vocations. A vocation is a call from the Holy Spirit, a gift from God that is nurtured in prayer. When we pray for vocations, we lift up to our Father those men and women whom He is calling to follow Him in a very special way. We hope that those who bring the cup home will continue to pray daily for vocations.

How the Program Works

Each week at Mass, an assigned family is invited to take the gifts up at the Offertory Procession. At the end of Mass, the family is called by the priest to come forward to receive the chalice, prayer binder, and a blessing. The family takes the chalice home and puts it in a place of honor. Each day for a week, during prayer time (morning, bedtime or at meals), the family prays for an increase and perseverance of vocations. They can also send a note of support to a Seminarian, Priest or Sister. On Saturday, the family returns the chalice and binder for another family to take home.

Divine Mercy Parish will have sign-ups after all masses this weekend - February 24 & 25.

¿Qué es un cáliz vocacional?

El propósito del **Programa Cáliz** es animar a las familias a **orar y promover las vocaciones al Sacerdocio y a la Vida Religiosa**. El Cáliz consagrado es un recordatorio tangible de esta intención especial para la Iglesia. El Concilio Vaticano II destaca la responsabilidad de los laicos de orar y apoyar las vocaciones. Este llamado urgente ha sido fuertemente afirmado en los escritos y discursos tanto del Papa Juan Pablo II como del Papa Benedicto XVI.

Orar por las vocaciones es la forma más poderosa de apoyar las

vocaciones. Una vocación es una llamada del Espíritu Santo, un don de Dios que se nutre en la oración. Cuando oramos por las vocaciones, elevamos a nuestro Padre a aquellos hombres y mujeres a quienes Él está llamando a seguirlo de una manera muy especial. Esperamos que aquellos que traigan la copa a casa continúen orando diariamente por las vocaciones.

¿Cómo funciona el programa?

Cada semana en la Misa, se invita a una familia asignada a recoger los regalos en la Procesión del Ofertorio. Al final de la misa, el sacerdote llama a la familia para que se acerque a recibir el cáliz, la carpeta de oración y una bendición. La familia se lleva el cáliz a casa y lo coloca en un lugar de honor. Cada día durante una semana, durante el tiempo de oración (por la mañana, antes de acostarse o durante las comidas), la familia reza por un aumento y una perseverancia de las vocaciones. También pueden enviar una nota de apoyo a un seminarista, sacerdote o hermana. El sábado, la familia devuelve el cáliz y la carpeta para que otra familia se los lleve a casa.

La Parroquia Divina Misericordia tendrá inscripciones después de todas las misas el fin de semana del 24 y 25 de febrero.
