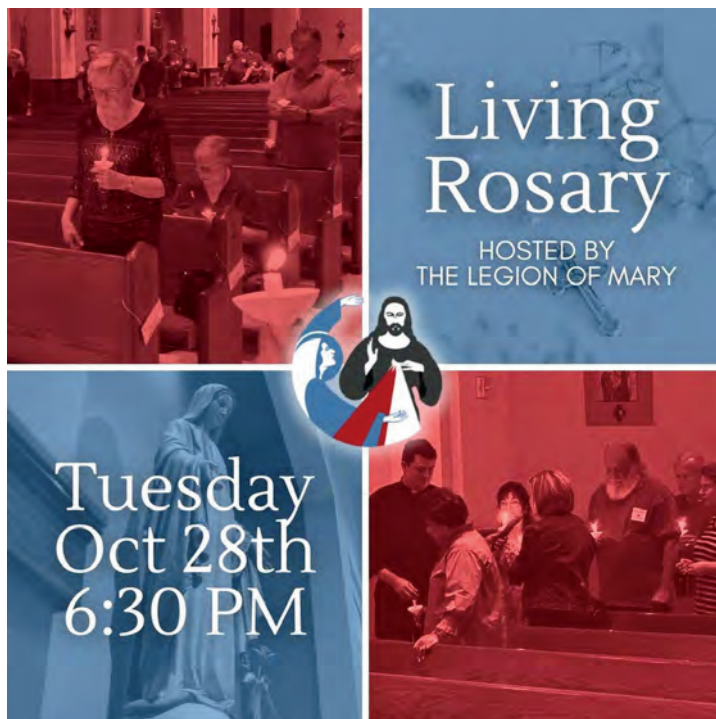

To celebrate the 2000 Jubilee, the
Louisiana State Knights of Columbus
commissioned a one-of-a-kind chalice.

This "**Millennium**" chalice was brought to the
Vatican by US Ambassador Lindy Boggs
and presented to Pope John Paul II.

**Pope John Paul II used the chalice to celebrate
Mass at St. Peter's Basilica on March 1, 2000, and
then it was brought back to Louisiana.**

**The Millennium Chalice will be used at
all masses the weekend of November 15 and 16.**



Mass Intention Requests for 2026 & New Mass Intention Request Policy

To accommodate the many requests for Mass intentions and in accord with Canon Law and Archdiocesan policy, Divine Mercy is updating the **Mass Intention Request Procedures**.

**Mass Intention Requests for 2026 will Open on
Wednesday, October 22 at 9:30 AM in the PCC.**

If you would like to request Mass Intentions for **Masses with a Single Intention** (Weekday Masses, Sundays at 8:30 AM and 4 PM, or Holy Days of Obligation) or a Specific Date, **please complete a Mass Intention Request Form and bring to the PCC at 9:30 AM on Wednesday, October 22.**

Requests will be honored on a First Come, First Served basis.

Mass Intention requests for masses with Multiple Intentions (Saturdays at 4 PM, Sundays at 10:30 AM and 12:30 PM) can be submitted at any time as the number of intentions is unlimited for those masses.

Policy for Requesting Mass Intentions

Terms

Mass Intention: The person or persons for whom the Mass is offered.

Mass with a Single Intention: Masses offered for only *the requested intention of one person* (The person requesting the intention(s)). One person can request multiple intentions for the same Mass including those Masses that are identified as single intentions. **Masses with single intentions are Weekday Masses, Sunday at 8:30 AM and 4 PM and Holy Days of Obligation.** (One Mass every Sunday and on Holy Days of Obligation must be scheduled for the intentions of our parishioners known as **Pro Populo** (For the People) as required by Canon Law.) This requirement is alternated between Sunday Masses at 8:30 AM and 4 PM.)

Mass with Multiple Intentions: Masses offered for the intentions of an unlimited number of people making a request. **Masses with Multiple Intentions are Saturday at 4 PM and Sunday at 10:30 AM and 12:30 PM.**

Policy for Requests

1. A requested intention may be made for any person living or deceased, in thanksgiving, or for an intention fitting to the Eucharistic celebration (Vocations, World Peace, Holy Souls in Purgatory, etc).
2. A Mass intention **may not be made for an unknown or unspecified "Special Intention"**. The *Special Intention* would be the **name of the person who has a Special Intention**.
3. The person requesting Mass to be offered can request an **unlimited** number of **Multiple Intention Masses** to be offered for their intention.
4. For Masses with a Single Intention, the person requesting is allowed to request the **same weekly Single Intention Mass Time a maximum of three (3) times in a calendar year**. (i.e. Sunday at 8:30 AM (3x's) and Tuesday at 7:30 AM (3x's) but no more than 3 for the same Mass time.) Additional Masses may be offered for this intention at Masses with Multiple Intentions.
5. Mass intentions scheduled at least two weeks prior to the Mass will be published in the bulletin for that week.
6. We begin to accept Mass intentions for the upcoming year at a date set and published in the parish bulletin.
7. Mass intentions will be honored on a first-come, first-serve basis.
8. The suggested offering for each requested Mass is \$5.

PLEASE NOTE: Initial requests for Masses with a Single Intention should be submitted on 10/22 at 9:30 AM to receive priority.

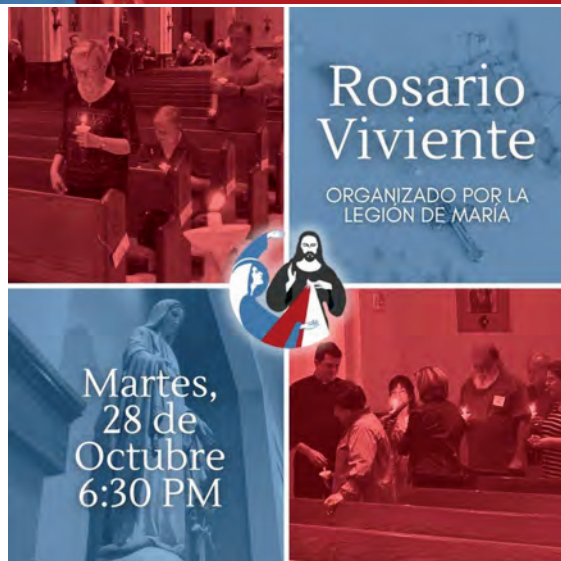
