The Millenium Chalice will be used at all masses this weekend of November 15 and 16.

To celebrate the 2000 Jubilee, the Louisiana State Knights of Columbus commissioned a one-of-a-kind chalice.

This "**Millenium**" chalice was brought to the Vatican by US Ambassador Lindy Boggs and presented to Pope John Paul II.

Pope John Paul II used this exact chalice to celebrate Mass at St. Peter's Basilica on March 1, 2000.

Due to the Pope's physical contact with the chalice, it is now revered as a second-class relic.

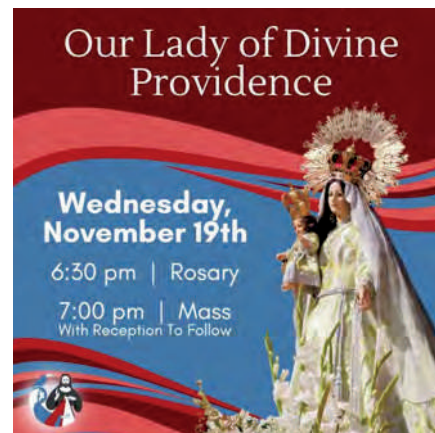
If you touch your rosary, or special religious item to the chalice, it will become a third-class relic!

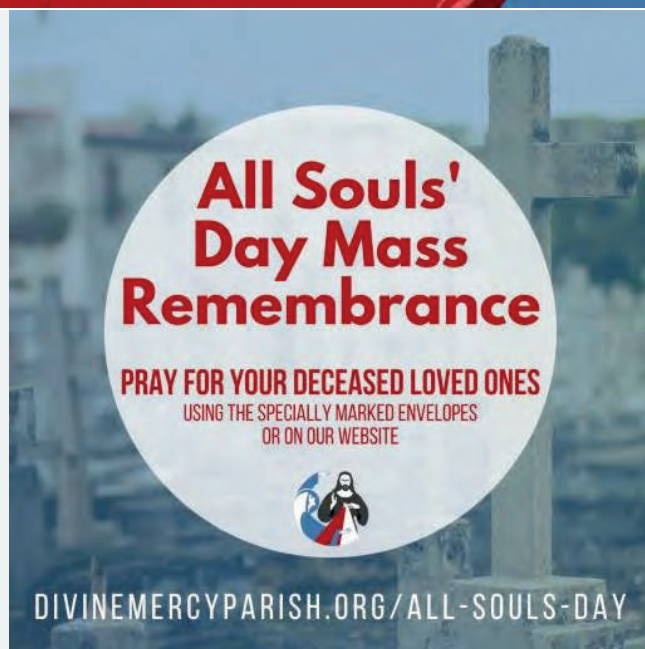
