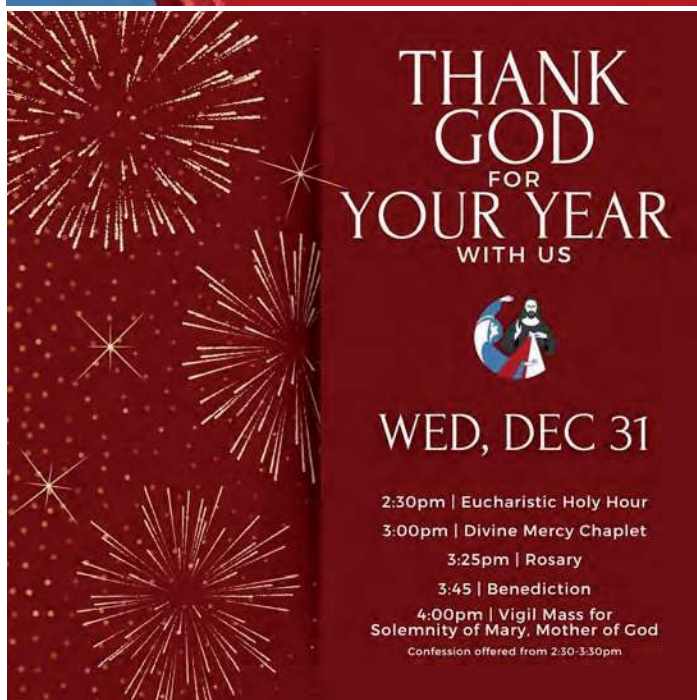

Many of our fellow immigrants are experiencing fear and distress right now. We ask for your prayers for these families who, out of fear, are reluctant to leave the safety of their homes.

We invite all people of faith and goodwill to join us in prayer for them, and also to help us collect and deliver (to homes) non-perishable food (that can be stored at room temperature).

Items that could be donated are the following:

Powdered Milk	Rice
Maseca Flour	Maruchan Soups
Sugar	Tortillas
Spam/Vienna Sausages	Canned Soups
Cookies	Cans of Tuna
Cereal	Bag of Beans
Maggi Soups	(red and black)
Pasta (spaghetti)	Bottle Vegetable Oil
Spaghetti Sauce	Bottled Water
Canned Chicken	Macaroni & Cheese

***Other necessary items such as diapers
(of all sizes and ages) and toilet paper.**

We will begin collecting these food items starting Sunday, December 14, after each Mass, and will continue collecting every Sunday as long as the situation warrants. We will have a container at the church entrance where you can place your donation. Monetary donations are also welcome to purchase the aforementioned items. You can also bring your donation to the church office Monday through Friday from 9 AM to 4 PM.

If you know of any family in the community that needs help with food, please contact Miguel at the parish office (504-466-5016). We need the name of the head of household, address (for delivery), and a phone number.

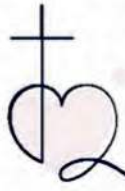
