The Blessing of Throats will take place at Divine Mercy Parish after all masses the weekend of January 31 and February 1 and following 7:30 AM Mass on Tuesday, February 3.

Catholics often participate in the tradition of having their throats blessed. To do this, the priest consecrates two candles, generally by a prayer, and then holds each in a crossed position on the throat of the person being blessed. At the same time, the following blessing is given: *“Through the intercession of Saint Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from ailments of the throat and from every other evil. In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.”*

Why does the blessing of the throat take place on St. Blaise Day? St. Blaise, a physician and bishop, asked God to cure a child who was choking to death on a fish bone and the child’s life was saved. Thus, St. Blaise is the patron saint of healthy throats.

La Bendición de Gargantas tendrá lugar en la parroquia de la Divina Misericordia después de todas las misas el fin de semana del 31 de enero y el 1º de febrero, y después de la misa de las 7:30 del martes 3 de febrero.

Los católicos suelen participar en la tradición de que les bendigan la garganta. Para ello, el sacerdote consagra dos velas, generalmente mediante una oración, y luego las sostiene en posición cruzada sobre la garganta de la persona bendecida. Al mismo tiempo, se da la siguiente bendición: *"Por la intercesión de San Blas, obispo y mártir, que Dios os libre de las dolencias de la garganta y de todo otro mal. En el nombre del Padre, del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo. Amén."*

¿Por qué se celebra la bendición de la garganta el Día de San Blas? San Blas, médico y obispo, pidió a Dios que curara a un niño que se estaba ahogando con una espina de pescado y la vida del niño fue salvada. Así, San Blas es el santo patrón de las gargantas sanas.


