**PALM SUNDAY
SUNDAY, MARCH 29**

The **holiest week of the calendar year begins with Palm Sunday** when the Gospel account of Jesus riding triumphantly into the city of Jerusalem is read before the priest even processes to the altar. The Passion account is read after the Gospel Acclamation, with the entire congregation reading together, entering into Christ's passion.

HOLY WEEK HAS BEGUN!

At the **10:30 AM and 12:30 PM Masses** we will have a **Solemn Procession from the PCC** to the church. At all other masses, we will process from the narthex into the main sanctuary.

We ask that all parishioners **bring their smart phones to church on Palm Sunday** to follow along with the **Passion Reading** and to **participate in the "Crowd" parts.**


