TALLER DE FORMACIÓN: VENCE LOS 7 PECADOS CAPITALES



Todos luchamos con debilidades que nos roban la paz, dañan nuestras relaciones y nos alejan de Dios. Muchas de estas luchas tienen su raíz en los **pecados capitales**, hacia los que la naturaleza humana caída tiende con facilidad. Se llaman “capitales” no por su magnitud, sino porque **dan origen a muchos otros pecados**.

Por eso, quien desea crecer espiritualmente y avanzar en la santidad necesita aprender a **reconocer estas inclinaciones en su propio corazón**, examinarlas con sinceridad y enfrentarlas con decisión.
