

## CEREMONY FOR THE ENTHRONEMENT OF THE SACRED HEART IN THE HOME

*At Masses on June 13-14, 8 x 10" images of the Sacred Heart will be blessed and distributed at all parishes for each household. The faithful are invited to enthrone the Sacred Heart in their homes that same weekend in the following manner:*

*Prepare the Image and Place*

- *Buy an 8x10" frame for the image*
- *Select a prominent place in your home (living room or main gathering space) for the image to be placed*

Sign of the Cross and Apostle's Creed

**Leader:** In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

**All:** Amen.

Reading from Sacred Scripture: Luke 19:1-10

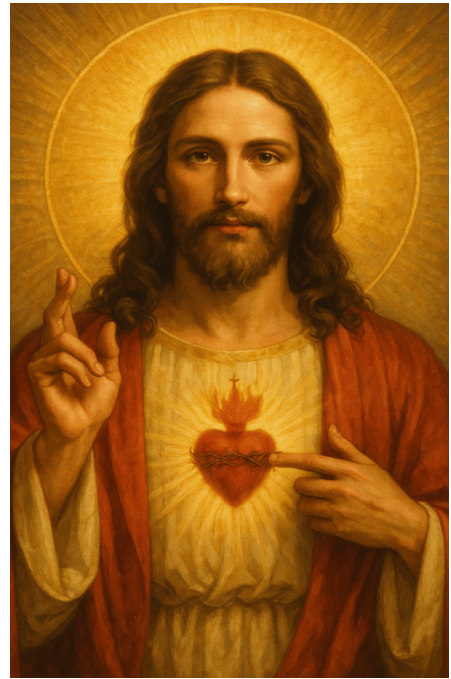
**R:** At that time, Jesus came to Jericho and intended to pass through the town. Now a man there named Zacchaeus, who was a chief tax collector and also a wealthy man, was seeking to see who Jesus was; but he could not see him because of the crowd, for he was short in stature. So he ran ahead and climbed a sycamore tree in order to see Jesus, who was about to pass that way. When he reached the place, Jesus looked up and said, "Zacchaeus, come down quickly, for today I must stay at your house." And he came down quickly and received him with joy. When they all saw this, they began to grumble, saying, "He has gone to stay at the house of a sinner." But Zacchaeus stood there and said to the Lord, "Behold, half of my possessions, Lord, I shall give to the poor, and if I have extorted anything from anyone I shall repay it four times over." And Jesus said to him, "Today salvation has come to this house because this man too is a descendant of Abraham. For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save what was lost."

Act of Enthronement of the Sacred Heart

*Reverently place the image in its chosen place. This act signifies giving Christ a place of honor as King of your home.*

**All:** "We/I now Enthroned the Lord Jesus as our/my personal King and Friend."

**All:** I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Creator of Heaven and Earth; and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, Our Lord; Who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried. He descended into Hell; the third day He rose again from the dead. He ascended into Heaven, and sits at the right hand of God, the Father Almighty; from thence He shall come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Catholic Church, the Communion of Saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body and life everlasting. Amen.

### *Multiperson Households*

### *Single Person Households*

**R:** Lord Jesus Christ, you appeared to the frightened apostles and said, “Peace be with you”: grant that your abiding peace may remain with the members of this household. We pray to the Lord.
