ABSTINENCE Those ages 18-59, in reasonable health, are required to fast on Good Friday. Those 14 and older must abstain from meat on Fridays during Lent. Canon Law does mention that for young children not fasting, parents should communicate the meaning and penance.

With numerous opportunities for confessions this week, the priests will not make private appointments for the Sacrament of Reconciliation in Holy Week.




