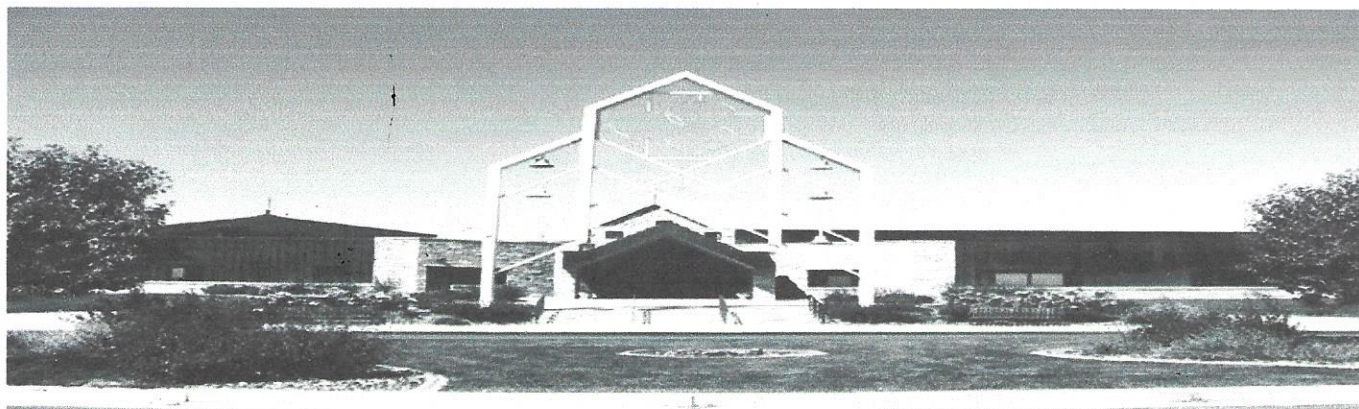

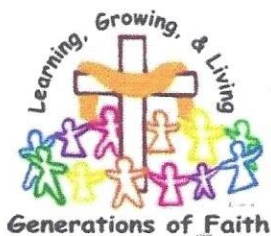

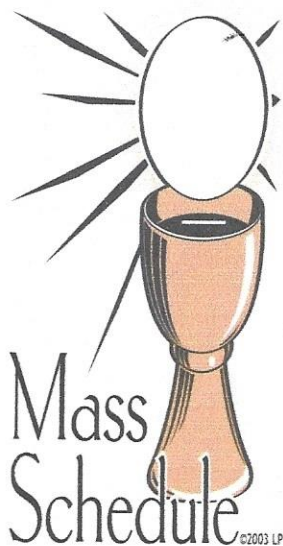

24th Sunday of Yr. A – 09/13/2020. Ref. 1st=Sir.27:30-28:7. 2nd=Rom.14:7-9. 3rd=Mtt.18:21-35.
Theme: That I may be forgiven

‘Forgiveness’ could be described as ‘the bandage with which God binds lovers or friends’. It keeps them together in love & friendship and helps to heal their injuries. Without it, no human relationship can last & we cannot be friends with God. The readings of today emphasize these.

Why should we forgive? In the 2nd reading of today, St. Paul tells us that, ‘None of us lives for himself/herself only’ (Rom.14:7). This simply tells us that we cannot survive without relationships – from birth to death. In the midst of these relationships, we come in contact with people of different backgrounds, environments, colors, trainings, understandings, beliefs, families, etc. which create rooms for misunderstanding and differences. Also, because of the fall of Adam & Eve, the human nature has become depraved & sinful (Rom.3:23, 1Jn.1:8). These make the need for forgiveness from each other and from God a necessity to share love among us and to inherit eternal life. As the Psalmist says, ‘If you, O lord should mark our sins, Lord who could stand? But with you is forgiveness, for this we revere you’ (Ps.130:3-4). That was why Jesus died & from the cross forgave his murderers (Lk.23:34). Hence, in the story of the ‘merciful master & unforgiven servant, He wants Peter & all of us to know that we should always express forgiveness without counting numbers. We do it not just because ‘we want to’ but also because ‘we ought to’. He also wants us to understand; 1). How forgiving God is to us – listening to our cries for mercy. 2). That we cannot survive the judgement/justice of God without His mercy. 3). How ungrateful we are to God’s forgiveness. 4). How easily we find reasons not to forgive those who offend us. 5). What will be our lot for not reciprocating God’s forgiveness to us.

Obstacles to forgiveness: The 1st reading of today lists some of the attitudes that work against forgiveness. First, Anger and Vengeful spirits. These make it difficult for us understand or give another ‘the benefit of the doubt’. When they overwhelm us, we close our minds to those who hurt us, refuse to accept any positive advice, seek to cause harm on another whom we see as obstructing our way of progress or want revenge for an offense against us. These lead us to make hateful decisions, make horrible mistakes or do regrettable things. That was the situation with the unforgiven servant in the gospel of today and could be the situation of any us at such moments. Anger got hold of him so much that he forgot the favor, mercy & forgiveness granted him by his master for much bigger debt, only to treat a fellow servant, owing him much less with anger & hatred. Hence, St. Paul warns, ‘You must not allow your anger to lead you to sin; never let the sun to set on your anger, else you will give the devil an opportunity’ (Eph.4:26-27). Another obstacle is our forgetfulness of our human nature that is subject to death, decay, final judgement & reward (from God). These should make us remove hatred & enmity from our lives (families & environments) since we cannot survive them without the mercy of God. Hence, He warns us, ‘The vengeful will suffer the Lord’s vengeance, for He remembers their sins in detail’ (Sir.28:1). Small wonder the unforgiven servant lost the earlier mercies granted him to suffer in the same way he had treated his fellow servant. Jesus ends the story by reminding us that God will treat us like this unforgiving servant, if we do not forgive each other from our hearts (Mtt.18:35). What a lesson! I hope you will forgive someone today.

My dear friends, the devil knows how beautiful & salvific Forgiveness is, that is why he works hard to weaken us there. Hence, we have many broken relationships, families and crisis in our societies today. Always know that Forgiveness gives us more than it takes from us; It gives us peace of soul, frees us from divine condemnation, makes our prayers heard and gives us the healings of body & soul (Sir.28:2-4). Think of the peace of mind we experience after a good sacramental confession. That is not the end of the story. As long as we live in this world, we should expect countless situations calling for our forgiveness wherever we meet fellow humans. As it is said, ‘When you live your life without anyone hurting, disappointing, disgracing or offending you, it means that you never did anything worthy’. Let us go home today to be agents of forgiveness (without counting numbers). Don’t be left out! **Remain blessed! Fr. Timothy.**
