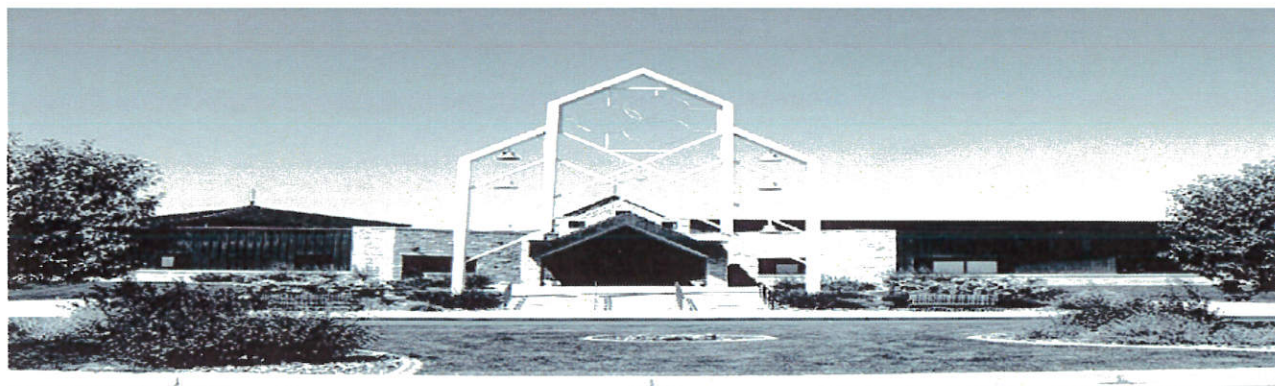

(Wis: 1:13-15, 2:23-24; 2Cor:8:7-9, 13-15; Mk: 5:21-43)

"HEALING TOUCH OF JESUS

'Your Faith Has Made You Well'

Dear friends in Jesus Christ,

Today's first reading instructs us that God created everything good and God is not the author of death. Man too was created for in-corruption and consequently to live eternally. But the devil (The Evil) brought death into the world. To overcome death and gain immortality, we must obey God the creator of everything. In the second reading, St. Paul urges the Christian community at Corinth to be generous towards the less fortunate (poor) in Jerusalem. Paul gives the example of Christ who although was rich in everything became poor for our sake. Those who have abundance need to take care of those in need.

"Little Girl, I Say to You, Arise"



Today's Gospel narrates two miracle stories:

1. The healing of a woman and the other, Jairus daughter being raised from the dead. In the first miracle a woman who had a hemorrhage for twelve long years touched the garment of Jesus with faith and she was instantly healed. Realizing that healing had taken place Jesus inquired who had touched Him. The woman although initially shocked acknowledged openly that she was healed by touching the garment of Jesus. Jesus commended her for her faith and told her, "daughter, your faith has made you well, go in peace".

2. Miracle took place when a synagogue official, by name Jairus, approached Jesus and requested Him to heal his daughter who was at the point of death. Jesus firmly told him, "do not fear only believe". Later Jesus went with Jairus to his house and brought back to life the little daughter of Jairus who was already dead.

Through these miracles, Jesus is inviting us to have faith in Him so that we too may experience His healing touch and we in turn may continue the healing ministry of Jesus. These miracles remind us that every follower of Christ ought to be a channel of the healing power of the Lord.

Every act of caring and sharing would cost us something. But if we keep ourselves in touch with the Lord, then the power of Jesus will be continuously restored to us.

Your Guide for Remembering What in the World Happens During Mass After Being Unable to Attend Because of a Global Pandemic!

Last week we heard a prayer/not-prayer that led us to some very substantial words from Pope John Paul II. This week (more Pope? ...maybe, be patient!), we finally get to respond to Fr. Priest!

**May the Lord accept the sacrifice at your hands
for the praise and glory of his name,
for our good
and the good of all his holy Church.**

So this one starts pretty straight forward—with us praying that the Lord accept the sacrifice (there's that word again!) at "your" hands. Wait? Who is "your?" Whose hands are we dealing with? Oh right! Fr. Priest has been offering up our sacrifices (bread and wine and everything) this entire time. So they are *his* hands—once again, thank your Fr. Priest for being Christ's worker on earth taking care of our souls!

Continuing through, we start to praise our Lord (like we are instructed in the Lord's Prayer [we'll get there soon]), and we acknowledge (in *every single Mass*) that the Lord and our sacrifice is for our own good. And even more amazingly, not just our own good, but for the good of *everyone* "all his holy Church." Because, what is his church? Who is his Church? WE ARE. It's our job to work and pray and volunteer and help and sing and read and visit the sick and imprisoned and do the dishes, and sweep the floor, and and and and...and all the ands. 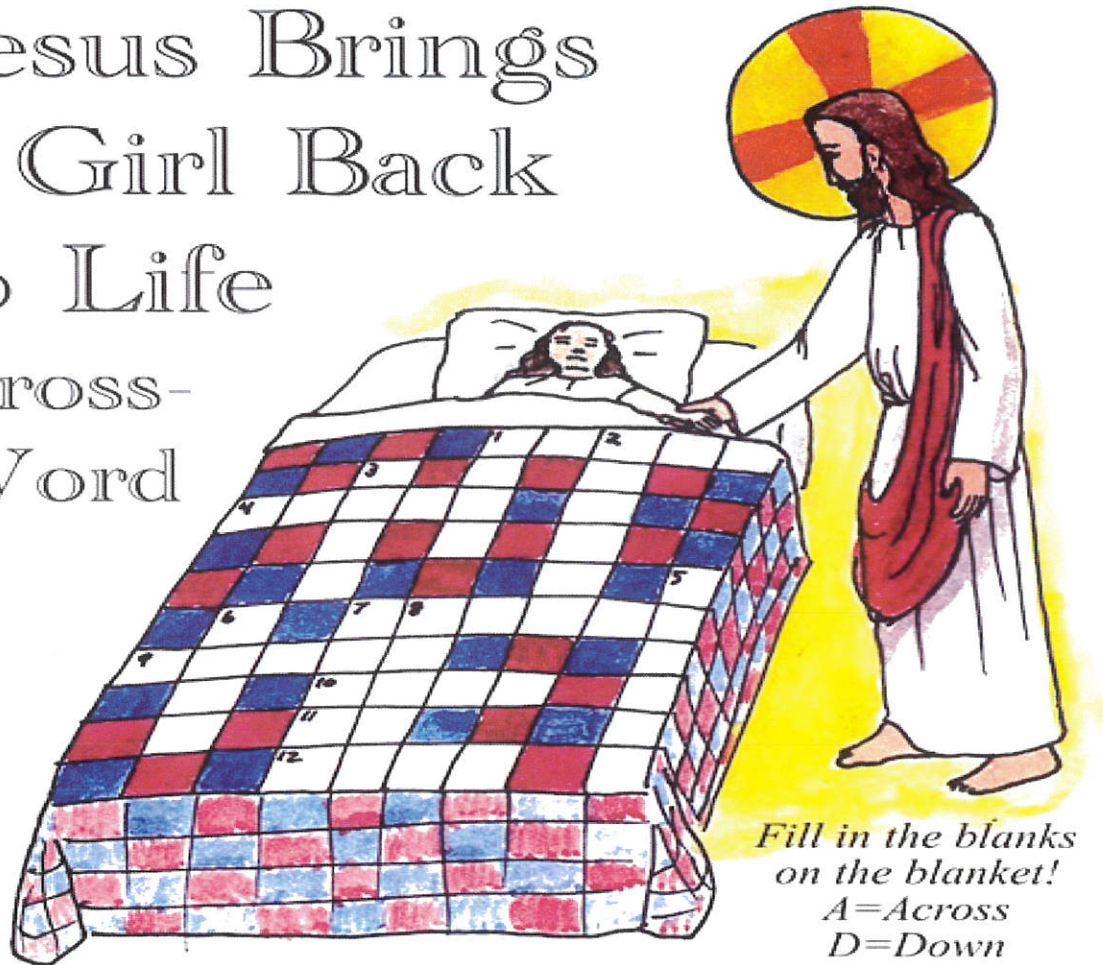

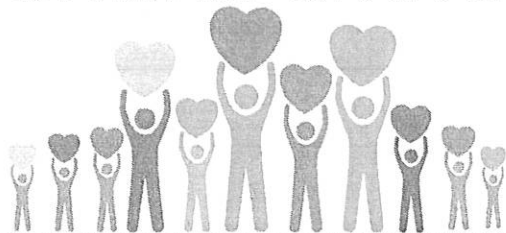

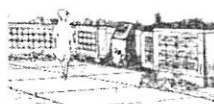
