

# TWENTY SECOND SUNDAY OF THE YEAR

(Deu:4:1-2,6-8; Ja:1:17-18,21-22,27; Mk:7:1-8,14-15,21-23)
"LIP SERVICE TO GOD AND MEN"

Dear friends in Jesus Christ,

In today's first reading, Moses exhorts the people of Israel to follow the statutes and ordinances of the Lord and keep the commandments. They were told not to add or deduct anything from them. As a wise and understanding people, they have to follow them in letter and spirit.

In the second reading, St. James, the Apostle reminds us that God can be loved and served only through our love for fellow humankind: especially by serving the poor and the orphans and the widows and the needy. He tells us that we have to be doers of the word and not merely hearers. That way we will be doing the will of God.

## "Your leave the commandments of God and hold fast to traditions"

In today's Gospel, Jesus confronts the Pharisees and the Scribes who accused His disciples of not keeping the traditions and practices of the Jews. This was told in the context of His disciples eating food without washing their hands as the Jewish custom was. According to their traditions they were expected to wash their hands before eating any food. Jesus went on to explain that what really makes us impure is not what we eat or drink: that which goes into the stomach but rather, what comes out of our heart: that is evil thoughts, desires, fornication, theft, murder and adultery.

Jesus is inviting us to have a close look at our set practices and observed traditions. He wants us to have a conversion of heart that will lead us to experience God. Let us not waste our precious lives in trivial matters but give importance for the essentials of life. It is not enough to do lip service to God and fellow humans but rather by concrete action which comes from our hearts.



#### Tour Guide of the Mass

Your Guide for Remembering What in the World Happens During Mass After Being Unable to Attend Because of a Global Pandemic!

On to the Epiclesis! Do you remember what it was? It was the interesting one where Fr. Priest invokes the Holy Spirit to consecrate the Eucharistic gifts. Yeah, extremely big (source, summit, best reason to attend Mass every week).

This is the point where, according to the Roman Missal, Fr. Priest has a few decisions to make. It is up to him to decide which Eucharistic Prayer (we discussed a couple weeks ago that there are four standard and several more for special occasions) he would like to use. For this tour, we are going to be using Eucharistic Prayer II (for those following along in the tour book). I picked (the one and only time I as a lay person can choose) this one because it is actually the shortest of the prayers...and I only have so much bulletin space!

There is something really interesting about this part of the Mass that you may not know. Just like a tour tells you where to go and how to get there, our Roman Missal tells Fr. Priest exactly what moves to make in order to get where we are going. What does that mean? Well...throughout this entire section there is red text (red means instruction—doing) which says:

> "With hands extended" "He joins hands" "With hands extended over the offerings"

Now, would that be so directed if it wasn't important? I don't think so! Keep an eye on the Mass today and watch exactly what Fr. Priest does in his motions. Next week, we will continue through the most important part of Mass, and delve into some of the prayers (and motions) that we use. Eeeeeekkk!!! I'm so excited!!! SM


