

THE FEAST OF PENTECOST: C: "THE DESCENT OF THE HOLY SPIRIT"

(Acts: 2:1-11; 1Cor:12:3-7, 12-13; Jn: 20:19-23)

Dear friends In Jesus Christ

I am well pleased to see you all through this Homily. Today's first reading is from the Acts of the Apostles. This passage gives us a detailed account of the happenings on the first Pentecost. Apostles were gathered in a particular place in Jerusalem. Suddenly the Holy Spirit descended on them and rested on them as tongues of fire, Filled with the Holy Spirit Apostles spoke in different languages. People who were in Jerusalem from various countries were able to listen to the Apostles in their own native languages. Hence at the first Pentecost Holy Spirit removed all barriers and divisions among humankind due to languages and races and united them in the one body of the Risen Lord.

The Second reading is from the first letter of St. Paul to the Corinthians. In this passage Paul speaks of the varieties of gifts given by the Holy Spirit to believers. He exhorts the Christians in Corinth and all of us to use these gifts for the good of all. Although we are different from each other, we form one body in Christ and we belong to each other in our common bond with him.

"Receive the Holy Spirit"

Today's Gospel reading is from St. John. The context is that the Risen Lord met the disciples who were fear stricken and were hiding from the Jewish authorities. The Lord appeared to them and wished them peace and gave them the gifts of the Holy Spirit and sent them on His mission. The effects of receiving the Holy Spirit were manifested on Pentecost Day. They were no more afraid of the Jews or afraid of anyone for that matter. They openly and fearlessly preached in Jerusalem about the death and resurrection of the Lord Jesus.

Hence from that day the disciples began to speak as the Holy Spirit prompted them. Until that day they had stayed behind closed doors but from the day of Pentecost they were ready to launch out into the open with boldness and courage. The outpouring of the Holy Spirit had an effect on the early Christian community as a whole. After the tragic death of Jesus, disciples were in total disarray. But now they found new strength in their oneness. They were united in mind and heart.

Let us also open our hearts to the Holy Spirit so that He may transform our lives and we become committed to the Lord.

"Breath in me, O Holy Spirit/ that my thoughts may all be holy.

Act in me O Holy Spirit/ that my work too may be holy.

Draw my heart O Holy Spirit / that I love but what is holy.


Strengthen me O Holy Spirit/ to defend all that is holy.

Tour Guide of the Mass

This week, our guidebook makes a jump from the *last page of the Mass* an alllll the way back to the page we talked about oh so long ago. Do you remember the Collect? And the Prayer Over the Offerings? Those were the prayers of Mass which change every week, and there are specific prayers written for each week (First Sunday in Ordinary Time, Third Sunday of Easter, all that jazz). Today we get to talk about the very *last* one of these prayers: The Prayer After Communion.

As the name might indicate, this prayer is the closing up of the Communion Rite, which also means it's the end of the Liturgy of the Eucharist (which is almost the last part of Mass, which means the bus is running out of gas!). There is something pretty intriguing about the Prayer After Communion, because it has a formula (SHOCK). I know, nothing in the entire Mass has a formula...OK, no more sarcasm, let's learn about the formula!

This prayer asks in different ways each week, that we may grow in Faith, Hope and Love. It asks that we be resurrected in Christ. It asks that we be redeemed through Christ our Lord.

Those last four words sound pretty familiar? They are part of our formula for this prayer. Let's look at what the GIRM (89) says:

- if the prayer is directed to the Father: Through Christ our Lord;
- if it is directed to the Father, but the Son is mentioned at the end: Who lives and reigns for ever and ever:
- if it is directed to the Son: Who live and reign for ever and ever.

There is something even cooler that the Holy Mother Church in her infinite wisdom does for us. Do you remember what the congregational response is after those bold words up there? Amen!

We say Amen, and that's important for a couple reasons. (Bullet points time! ... albeit a short set).

- 1. Amen is a declaration. Way back when, we talked about what that weighty word means: So Be It. So It Is.
- 2. The congregation saying "Amen" declares that the Prayer After Communion is *ours*. It is not a silent prayer for only Fr. Priest, but a prayer spoken by him so that we all can join in together at the end and "Make the Prayer [our] own" (GIRM 89).

Check back in next week, don't blink or you might miss it! SM

Kids Corner- Pentecost Sunday

The feast of Pentecost came nine days after Jesus had ascended into Heaven. The disciples and Mary were praying together when the Holy Spirit suddenly came with the sound of a huge wind and what looked like flames of fire coming down on each of them. The apostles went right out and began to preach and teach people about Jesus.

The Holy Spirit comes to us in Baptism and lives in us whenever our souls are in a state of grace (when we don't have any serious sins.) He comes into us more whenever we receive a Sacrament, especially Confirmation. He helps us do what is right and serve God using all the gifts He gives us. The Holy Spirit, who is the third Person of the Blessed Trinity, draws us closer to God the Father and Jesus.

Pray to the Holy Spirit every day to help you to do everything for God. Then see how your life changes!




