





FOURTEENTH SUNDAY OF THE YEAR: A: INVITATION OF JESUS TO REST A WHILE (Zech: 9: 9-10; Rom: 8: 9 and 11-13; Mat: 11: 25-30)

Dear friends in Jesus Christ,

I am very happy to see you all through this Homily. Today's first reading is from the book of the Prophet Zechariah. In this passage Zechariah urges the people of Israel to rejoice because their promised leader -Messiah- is coming. The Messiah is not coming as a proud warrior but he is full of humility. He is victorious but peace loving. He is triumphant but humble. This prophecy of Zechariah finds its fulfillment in the person of Jesus.

The second reading is from the letter of St. Paul to Romans. In this passage Paul tells the Christian community in Rome and all of us that we have the Holy Spirit living in us. He further adds that authentic Christian life is lived in union with the spirit of Christ and it results in the fullness of life. But a sinful and sensual life is a living death and results in the destruction of life.

"Come to me all who labour and are heavy laden and I will give you rest"

Today's Gospel reading is from St. Matthew. In this passage Jesus openly invites everyone who is humble, gentle and overburdened. There are very few of us who can say that we are not burdened by life situations. Jesus is the embodiment of the heavenly Father's goodness and all those who follow Him will find true rest and reassurance.

"Come to me" is a great invitation from the Lord to everyone of us. This invitation of Jesus is open to everyone in different age groups and to all classes of people in the society. It is an invitation to all people - the working, the struggling and the oppressed. It is an invitation to those who do manual works or mental works and Jesus offers true rest. No matter who we are and what we do we all get weakened, tired and enfeebled. Rest is a universal need: we need physical, mental and spiritual rest. Jesus is ready to give us that rest.

THE HOLY EUCHARIST IS THE LOVE OF GOD; BY NADINE DRAKE

"No one has a greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friend" (John 15:13). In the Gospel of John, Jesus says "I am the bread of life; he who comes to me shall not hunger, and he who believes in me shall never thirst" (John 6:35). The Holy Eucharist is Jesus Christ; Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity, which He gave to us out of love. Everything that God; Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, does, is done out of love for us. God is a necessary being that does not need to create anything to be perfect, not even us but he did create us because he loves us. We are his image and likeness.

The sixth day of creation is when God created the humans. He created us in His image and likeness, to be dependent on him, our God, for everything. God has called us to be in communion with Him from the beginning. When He created Adam and Eve they were in full communion with God, living in harmony with God and creation. God created us "with a spiritual soul and intellect. The human person is from his very conception ordered to God and destined for eternal beatitude. He pursues his perfection in "seeking and loving what is true and good" (Catechism, 1711)".

God wanted us to be free and therefore gave us Free Will. With the free will that Adam & Eve were given, they ate the fruit that God instructed them not to eat. Due to temptation from the devil they fell and we have inherited that Original Sin. When we are born it is washed away by the Sacrament of Baptism that Jesus Christ gave to us. Baptism is the first Sacrament that we receive to be reborn into the family of God. We have to be washed by Baptism and have an indelible mark on our souls before entering into full communion with Him whose nature and image we have shared from the beginning of time.


Jesus, the Eucharist, is the gift of God's love. The Holy Eucharist is the sacrament of washing away our sins, it is for purification for us "and for many for the forgiveness of sins". Before coming to earth Jesus knew that we are sinners and not worthy of Him, but He came anyway to save us. Jesus is perfect and all that He did was out of love and truth.


He could have come to earth as anything and in any way because He is God, but he chose to come in the most humble and vulnerable way, as a baby. He was not born in some fancy or immaculate place, but in a stable through a mother with an immaculate heart. After Jesus was born, His mother "wrapped Him in swaddling clothes, and laid Him in a manager" (Luke 2:7). Jesus came not only in a stable but was also placed in a manager. A manager is the feeding place of animals, and from His very birth, Jesus was placed there. Jesus was originally placed in a feeding trough.
