WHAT IF YOU WERE ASKED? BY MARTI GARCIA, PARISHIONER, ST. COLUMBA, DURANGO

Many devotional readings and theologians have stated that Jesus wants us to ask Him in prayer. What a simple request! Yet, every day, I find myself grappling with this question. Either I feel capable of handling the situation and don't want to bother Jesus with my prayers, or I simply forget to ask. That's my pride taking over, bullying its way into the situation. How many have experienced God's answers to prayers and felt truly filled with His peace and understanding? Once you experience that, you yearn to feel His presence more and more. I read recently that the simplest prayer request pleases the Lord. A dear friend once shared that they talk to Jesus so frequently that one day, they paused their prayer conversation and asked, "Am I talking so much that you stop listening?" The Lord answered, "I always love to hear you share and speak to me about your day and concerns."

Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you." What if Jesus asks you a question? Are you open to His message, and do you feel worthy? I was asked to be a sponsor, or godparent, by a catechumen. At first, I thought I wasn't a strong enough Catholic in my faith. Then I wondered if I had the time. I wasn't sure what that role truly entailed. Taking a deep breath, I felt overwhelmed with humility that this person would ask me to share in this incredible journey. I noticed the nervousness in her eyes, and before I knew it, I said yes, I would be glad to. Truthfully, when I got home that day, I looked up what it means to be a sponsor. As I read the definition, doubts began to creep in. Am I an upstanding, active Catholic?

I guess that doesn't mean do I physically work out. Will I be there to support, answer questions, and be a mentor? With my mind swirling with questions and uncertainties, I remembered that I needed to seek the Lord for understanding. "Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks, receives; and the one who seeks, finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened."

(Matthew 7:7-8) We humans aren't perfect, and yes, we are all sinners. I have learned to use the gift of discernment to help me walk in my faith. Discernment doesn't mean judgment; it actually means (in a Christian context) to obtain spiritual guidance and understanding. I like to think of it as asking the Lord to hold my hand and guide me in His ways. Our ultimate goal is to do His will, not our own. I realized that if Jesus wanted me to help mentor this catechumen and I drew on Mary as an example, I would say yes. Working on complete trust is always a work in progress. Just start with the first step, and each subsequent step will lay before you. If you don't take any step at all, you can see how this turns you around and heads you in the opposite direction of what he asks of you. "Though young men faint and grow weary, and youths stagger and fall, They that hope in the Lord will renew their strength, they will soar on eagles' wings;

They will run and not grow weary, walk and not grow faint." (Isaiah 40:30-31) I haven't looked back since saying yes. You might be surprised to learn that you, too, will grow in faith as you embark on this spiritual journey with your catechumen. You will be amazed by the gifts the Holy Spirit bestows upon those entering the Catholic faith. You have a front row seat.

The Holy Longing, the Search for a Christian Spirituality


By Ronald Rolheiser, © 1999, 239 pgs.




At first it seems kind of sad that Jesus left His friends, doesn't it? But how could they be sad when Jesus was returning with joy to His Father in Heaven?


