

April 19, 1925 marked the official institution of Court # 941 in the State of Colorado.

The Court first organized at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Grand Junction. As the Grand Valley grew, members were drawn also from Immaculate Heart of Mary, St. Ann in Palisade and Sacred Heart in Fruita.

The current membership is a strong 75 members.

As the motto for Catholic Daughters is Unity and Charity, our presence is felt all over the Valley. We have been called upon to provide meals for the Deanery Priest Retreat, bake succulent desserts for Fruita K of C for their Lenten Fish Fry, hold an annual collection for Birthright of the Grand Valley, support the Lady Veterans in the VA Hospital as well as Catholic Outreach by providing items for the Day Center and workers for the Soup Kitchen. Spiritually we attend First Saturday Mass at IHM, taking a priest to breakfast and offering Memorialized Candles for all in the Valley to remember their deceased loved ones on All Soul's Day.

We meet once a month from September to June, generally on Sunday from 1:30 pm to 3:30 pm.

We hold an annual Card Party/Silent Auction once a year and stepped it up a bit in 2025 with a Duck Pull to commemorate our 100th Anniversary of our Court and raised funds in support of the establishment of a Catholic High School in the Valley.

We are called to serve as was evident in September 2024 to support the Fall Festival at IHM and the Dedication of the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Fruita and were honored to feed the bodies of the Totus Tuus group this year..

We have a robust schedule planned for 2025-2026. Information will be posted on the bulletin board and through our Officers, Ambassadors and members.





# The Holy Cross

Today we celebrate the feast of the Exaltation, or Triumph, of the Holy Cross on which Our Lord died. The cross was an instrument of torture used to punish criminals and to show other people what would happen to them too, if they broke the Roman laws. Our Lord used the cross for a different reason though. He offered His sufferings on the cross to repay for the sins of everyone else in the world. He died in a place where many people could see Him so that they could see and know how much He loves us.

In the 300's AD, St. Helena, who was a Christian queen, went to Jerusalem to find the cross of Jesus. She found three crosses there so she decided to test to see which was Christ's. A very sick woman touched each cross. When she touched the third one she was healed instantly! They had found the cross of Christ!




*In hoc signo, vinces!* Saint Helena's son Constantine was not a Christian yet, but when he was about to go to war he had a vision of the cross and heard the words "In this sign you shall conquer!" So he had crosses drawn on all the flags and shields, and he won the battle. Then he believed in Jesus and became a Christian.
