Meditation

Two Special Days

Halloween is on Tuesday and with the bustle of finding a costume and eating candy, we often forget the two days following this are very special in our Catholic life.

All Saints' Day falls on Wednesday and is a holy day of obligation. The veneration of the saints is an ancient part of our faith. This solemnity was established by the ninth century. Unlike what we are often accused of, we do not worship the saints, but we venerate them which means we regard them with great respect. Whether they have been canonized because they were a martyr, lived a holy life, or were a prophet, we ask them to act as intermediaries in our prayers to God.

The day following is celebrated as All Souls' Day and has a long tradition. It is said that in ancient times the poor would go around and beg for food and then promise to pray for the dead in return. They called the little cakes they received "soul cakes" (sounds a bit like trick or treat goodies). In Mexican culture, "The Day of the Dead" (El Dia de los Muertos) is a rich tradition celebrated on November 2. This celebration of "memorial" day is observed in other cultures as well. In the Philippines, a novena for the holy souls culminates on November 2. Special celebrations are also observed in Hungary and Poland.
