## Meditation

### Listen to Understand

Remember that our Gift of the Holy Spirit this month is that of understanding. We cannot understand if we are not listening. Sometimes our minds wander during the readings at Mass. What can we do to keep that from happening?

We have already talked about how the first reading and the Gospel are tied together. Let's move on to the other parts of the Liturgy of the Word. (i.e., "the readings")

The Responsorial Psalm is just that. It's a psalm that continues the theme of the readings. As we pray or sing the psalm, we should try to imagine Jesus praying the psalm. We can join our praying to that of His.

The second reading, which may or may not tie into the theme, is a letter to the people of the times. As we listen to that, we should try to see what was going on in the church that the apostle is addressing. How does it relate to our parish? How might it relate to our lives?

*Lord, help us to really listen to you!*
