# **Trinity Sunday**

### Meditation

### **God In Three Persons**

In an essay from 2005, Elaine Rendler-McQueeney talks about a time when the concept of the trinity was challenged.

"The Council of Nicea was convened by the Emperor Constantine and took place in 325 AD because of the Arian heresy... The Arian heresy involved the Trinitarians, who insisted there were three persons in one God, and the Monarchianists who believed in only one indivisible God, who created a second being, the third part of a chain. This denies the divinity of Jesus. Jesus has the same nature as the Father. Since a mere human couldn't redeem humans, the heresy, in fact, denied the redemption of Jesus. Without Jesus' redemptive act, our sufferings would have no meaning, nor would we be able to share in the divine life as won for us by Jesus through his suffering, death, and resurrection. The Nicene Creed is a result of this first Council....

Today's well-known Gospel, John 3:16-18 ('God so loved the world') has greater significance if viewed in the light of this chapter of Church history. Today's preface clarifies any doubt about the divinity of Jesus." (Today's preface-in part-: "For with your Only Begotten Son and the Holy Spirit you are one God, one Lord: not in the unity of a single person, but in a Trinity of one substance.")
