### **The National Eucharistic Revival**

Our world is hurting. We all need healing, yet many of us are separated from the very source of our strength. Jesus invites us to return to the source and summit of our faith in the celebration of the Eucharist. The National Eucharistic Revival is a movement to restore understanding and devotion to this great mystery here in the United States by helping us renew our worship of Jesus Christ through the Eucharist.

The Bishops of the United States are calling for a three-year grassroots revival. It aims to inspire, educate, and unite the faithful in a more intimate relationship with Jesus in the Eucharist. The pillars of this are Reinvigorating devotion (receive Jesus, worship Jesus); Deepening formation (learn and preach the truth about Jesus); and Missionary sending (go out and bring Jesus to the world).
