

Ash Wednesday

This Wednesday we begin Lent with the Mass and reception of ashes on Ash Wednesday, a day which is always 46 days before Easter Sunday. Lent is a time of preparation for Easter marked by repentance, fasting, reflection, and ultimately celebration.

Ash Wednesday serves as a time for Christians to reflect on their lives, confess their sins, seek repentance, and prepare spiritually for the celebration of Easter. It is a solemn day that signifies humility, mortality, and the acknowledgement of human frailty. Christians also engage in fasting and self-denial during the Lenten season as a way of drawing closer to God.

Ash Wednesday is a day of fasting for those 18-59 where one main meal and two smaller meals can be eaten. It is a day of abstinence for those 14 and older where no meat is to be eaten.
