Devotion To God

Since we are now entering into Ordinary Time in the Church year and our priests and deacons do an excellent job of providing understanding of the readings, let’s talk about our Catholic faith for a few weeks.

Catholics form a diverse community of varied ethnic and national groups that share a sense of belonging to the formal institution of the Catholic Church. The religious aspect of Catholicism is its belief in and understanding of God. Catholics learn how to live their lives based on their devotion to God, and Catholicism offers them a way of life that is based on specific doctrines, faith, theology and a firm sense of moral responsibility. These elements based on the Scriptures later evolved through tradition.
