### Meditation

#### The Grace of God

The Catholic Church is a living, growing entity. Open to changes which come with the changing world, it also stands by some basic doctrines that it has always held to be true. The most basic of the Church’s doctrines is the idea that we achieve salvation through divine grace. Divine blessings are an expression of God’s love. There are two mysteries by which God expresses this love. We’ll look at one today and the other next Sunday.

The Catholic belief is that God is a real, living presence in the Eucharist. The Celebration of the Eucharist is the centerpiece of Catholic worship. During the Mass, we partake of bread and wine that, through consecration becomes the Mystical Body and Blood of Christ. Through this process, known as “transubstantiation”, the bread and wine are literally changed to Christ’s body and blood. In sharing this sacrament, the entire Catholic community is united in communion with Christ. (from *The Everything Catholicism Book*, Keeler & Grimby)
