Meditation

Blessings for the Lowly Ones

This Sunday shows us how God sees things differently than we do. In each reading, we hear about people that the world may overlook—those who are weak, poor, or humble. But God lifts them up. He sees their faith and their trust.

The Gospel gives us the Beatitudes. Jesus tells us who is truly blessed. It is not the rich or the powerful but those who show mercy, those who are gentle and those who suffer for doing what is right. These words are simple, but they show us how to live as followers of Christ.

The other readings also remind us to stay humble. God saves a small group in Zephaniah. Paul tells the Corinthians that God chooses the weak on purpose. The psalm praises God for helping the poor and needy. These are all reminders that God is close to the lowly.

Let us pray to God that we may be one of the lowly.
