### **QUESTIONS TO PONDER:**

In the Gospel today someone asks Jesus a question about how many will be saved and go to heaven. Jesus does not respond with a specific number but challenges his listener to go through the narrow door. This image of a door was easily understood because of the way cities were constructed, a wall city had several entrances. There was the city gate which was wide enough to admit crowds of people, camels loaded with goods, and soldiers on the march. Beside this gate there was a single doorway in the wall which allowed one person at a time to pass through and enabled those charged with protecting the city to have more control.

God has fashioned us for salvation and eternal life in his kingdom. Over and over in the scripture reference is made to his divine plan that all will be saved. However the repeated infidelity of our ancestors calls this into question. The purpose of Jesus coming into the world was to seek out the lost children of Israel. Among these were those who had abandoned the faith of their fathers and adopted pagan ways; those who had a minimal acquaintance with the faith of Abraham and were not very devout; those who selected from revelation what they chose to believe; the Pharisees who constricted the practice of their faith and kept a watchful eye on those who did not follow their example; the prophets who were called and sent to challenge the people to be faithful. Jesus meets all of these in his journey to Jerusalem and offers many of them a taste of the kingdom. He heals their illnesses, forgives their sins, feeds their hunger, reveals some of the mysteries of the kingdom and invites them to come, take up your cross and follow me.

He speaks about life in his Father's house and promises a repentant thief "today you will be with me in paradise." It is not our prerogative to know or determine who is saved and despite some who claim to be "saved" we all depend on the mercy of God. To follow Jesus' instructions we listen to his word, take it to heart, act on it and trust Him as a profound act of humility. This is the way through the narrow door that leads to eternal life. As to who or how many all we know that God has made us for life with him and trust that we will discover the path that leads us to salvation.

## WHAT IS AN ACOLYTE?

In 1972, in the apostolic letter *Ministeria Quaedam*, Pope Paul VI, abolished the traditional minor clerical orders and replaced them with two offices: that of reader and the acolyte. It is the reader who serves at the table of the Word, and the acolyte serves at the table of the sacrifice.

In the Diocese of Pittsburgh, men who have been accepted into the deacon formation program enter a one-year period called the propaedeutic period, where the aspirant and the Church discern a call to Holy Orders. Following this period, the aspirant, if he and the Church have determined that this call may be authentic, is formally invited to further discernment as a candidate for holy orders through the Rite of Admission to Candidacy. Over the next 4 years, the candidate may be invited to continue his formation through two consecutive Rites of Institution. First, the candidate may be invited to petition the bishop to be instituted as a reader, and then he may be invited to petition the bishop to be instituted as an acolyte.

The duties of the acolyte at Mass are beautifully summed up in the bishops' words to the candidate for Holy Orders as he kneels before him during the Mass of Institution. "Take this vessel with bread for the celebration of the Eucharist. Make your life worthy of your service at the table of the Lord and the Church."

In this way, the acolyte is appointed to aid the deacon and to minister to the priest in [a distinct way](#). It is his duty to attend to the service of the altar and to assist the deacon and the priest in liturgical celebrations, especially in the celebration of Mass; he is also to distribute Communion as an extraordinary minister in the absence of a deacon, illness of the priest or if the need arises for additional extraordinary ministers as deemed necessary. In extraordinary circumstances, an acolyte may be entrusted with publicly exposing the Blessed Sacrament for adoration by the faithful and afterward replacing it. However, an acolyte may not bless the faithful under any circumstance.

In assisting the priest, in the absence of a deacon, the acolyte prepares the altar, assists as an Extraordinary Ministry of Holy Communion, and purifies the vessels after communion at the credence table. If the precious blood is distributed, it is proper for the acolyte to perform this task in the absence of the deacon. If incense is being used, the acolyte presents the thurible to the priest and assists him while he incenses the offerings, the cross, and the altar. Then the acolyte incenses the priest and the people.

May the Holy Cross be your light,
