



We are happy to have others join us for Mass even if and when they enter in the middle of our celebration. Everyone is welcome at every and any moment! You are never a bother to us and we understand that life happens!

Cleanliness and Modesty are appreciated and respected, know that we thank you in advance for trying not to dress in ways that could distract others from our praise of the Lord and our celebration of the Church's sacraments. Please know, however, that having you join us as you are, is more important to us.

Remember! God loves you for who you are, as you are, and so do we!

A HARD SAYING: The Gospel today presents us with one of the hard sayings of Jesus. He expresses His desire that His followers should love Him above all else. This is an application of the first commandment "To love God above all." To explain this application Jesus applies hyperbole to make the point. He does not intend this only for His twelve disciples but preaches it to the great crowd in front of Him. If you wish to be my disciple then you must love me more than anyone or anything else. On face value it does not seem like an easy position. It implies that we should love all others less and not be so attached to anything in this world but to focus all our attention and love on Him.



From the beginning of our relationship with Jesus at baptism we are invited to be united to Jesus so as to share in the salvation He offers us. He makes a point of telling us not to lose our way by trying to substitute someone or something for a relationship with Him. To enable us to follow Jesus, He gives us many helps. He gives us the gift of faith, He reveals His wisdom over earthly wisdom and He offers us access to His heavenly father. It may seem ironic but if we love Jesus we cannot help but love others. If we cast our lot with Jesus, He helps us carry our burdens and blesses us in every way. He enables us to see beyond the limited vision of today and promises us the eternal vision of His heavenly home.

Since we can become weighed down by earthly concerns, burdens and needs, He gives us His spirit and shows us the way to follow our path to Him. Jesus has freed us from the results of Adam's sin and shares His life with us. We look on Him and to Him to reveal God's plan for us. As we learn Jesus and become more like Him we achieve the purpose for which we were made.

We are no longer slaves but have been freed to become sons and daughters of a loving Father, who enables us to perfect our love for others. If we love Him more we will be able to love others best. The command to hate others is to dispel selfish love and to have a purified love for all. In Jesus we are no longer slaves to our old self but free to God and our brothers and sisters as ourselves.

A WORD FROM OUR SEMINARIAN... On August 20th, the Church celebrated the memorial of St. Bernard who is a doctor of the Church. He was born in 1090 near Dijon, France. He was a member of the Cistercian Order and was the Abbot of Clairvaux. He died in the year 1153. St. Bernard was canonized in 1174 and declared a Doctor of the Church in 1830.

While I was looking at the Office of Readings for St. Bernard, something struck me from a homily of his that can be found in the breviary for that particular day. This particular homily focuses on love. He tells us that love needs to have clear focus and that focus is back to God who is love itself. God loves us and wants us to want to love Him back.

There are many ways that we show God our love. The most obvious way is through prayer. Prayer is a conversation with God. Just as we need to stay in contact with our friends and family by talking to them, we too need to have regular conversations with God in order to grow in our love for Him. Without a prayer life, it is hard for us to grow in our love for God who is the giver all of life and out of love, came down to earth in order that we may obtain salvation.

Another way that we can express our love for God is through the service to our fellow man. As we hear in Matthew 25, "Amen, I say to you, whatever you do for one of these least brothers of mine, you did for me." We are all created in the image and likeness of God and when we serve others in our community in ways such as volunteering or donating clothes or other goods, you are showing you love for God.

As I close out this brief message, may each one of us strive to grow in our love for God. For when we pray and do service towards others, we are able to grow in our love for God who humbled Himself to take on our humanity for the salvation of all. Please be assured of my prayers for each one of you and please continue to pray for me.


