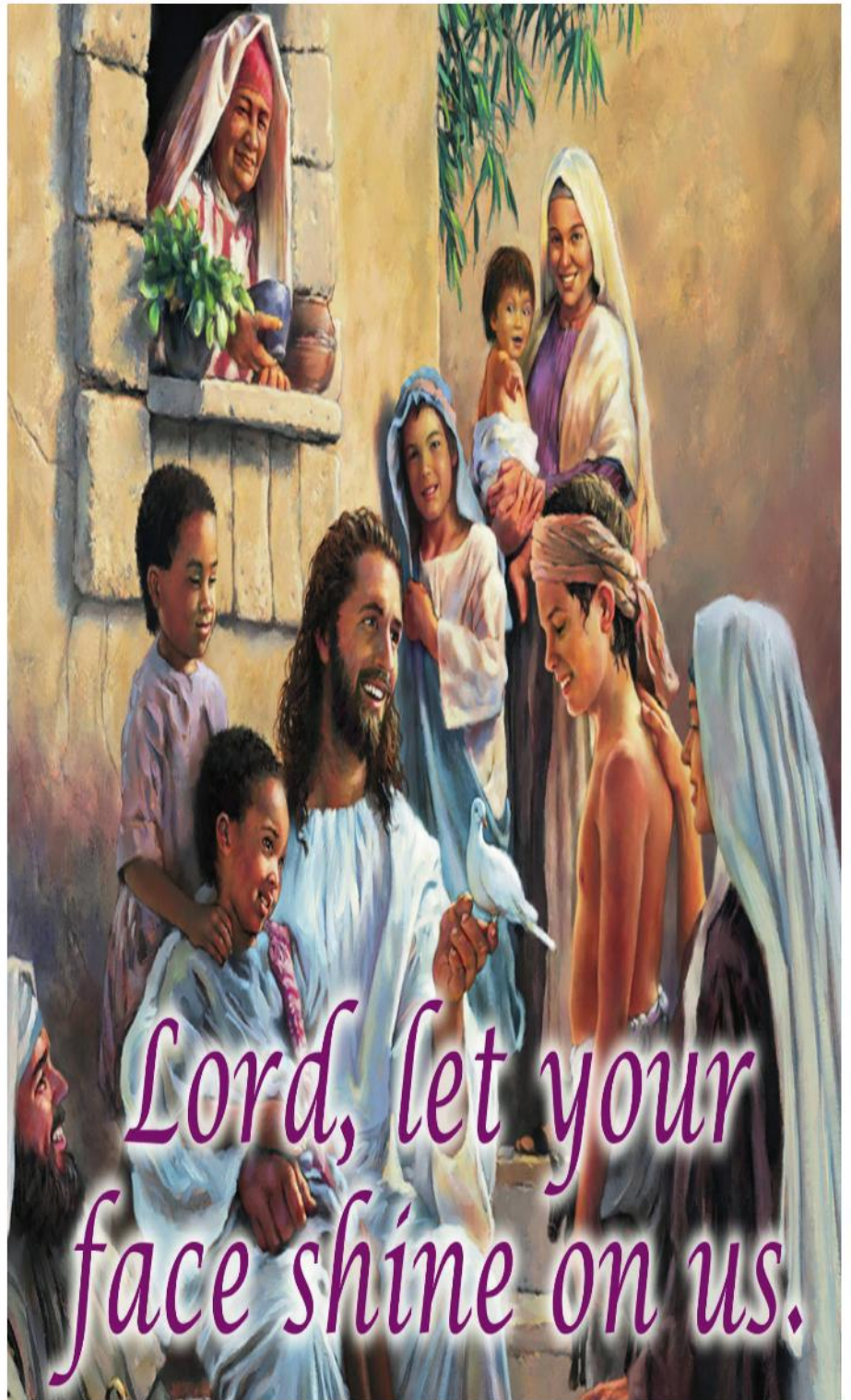

From Father Zach...

I've been thinking a lot of Pope Francis recently, especially since his sudden death on Easter Monday and his funeral on Easter Saturday. He had been Pope during my entire priesthood. I had the privilege of seeing him in person twice. The first time was when I went on pilgrimage to Rome with the seminarians at St. Vincent Seminary back in 2014. I was in St. Peter's Square on a Sunday afternoon, when he appeared on the balcony, praying the Angelus and giving a short message. The second time was in 2016, when a friend and I went to Rome on pilgrimage for the "Jubilee Year of Mercy." I attended a "General Audience" (what they call his Wednesday morning talks in St. Peter's Square). In fact, the picture of the Pope was taken from my camera as he rode on the Popemobile through the Square before his talk. I was very fortunate to be in the right place at the right time in order to get that perfect shot.

One quote of his that I recall is when he called the Church a "field hospital." A field hospital is a makeshift hospital that medics set up near a battlefield in order to tend to wounded soldiers. This is a beautiful image of the Church! The Church is not a museum of saints, but a large gathering of sinners. We are all weak and wounded in some way, seeking the refreshment and healing that Christ offers through the Scriptures and the Sacraments.

Another quote of his that I remember fondly is when he said that shepherds must "smell like the sheep!" Sheep have a distinctive smell. When shepherds tend to them closely enough, the smell gets on them. In a similar way, clergy (and by extension, the lay faithful) must not minister to others from a distance, but instead spend time with the sheep, understanding what they're going through, and being so close to them that, in a sense, they smell like the sheep.

For the past two years, I've had the privilege of reading translations of some of the Pope's talks on WAOB radio. One thing that impressed me was the tone of these talks. He spoke in a very informal, down to earth way, from the heart. I'm glad that I practiced reading the talks before recording them. I remember a few times when the Pope used humor in these talks, and I'd laugh out loud in the middle of reading it! It would not have been good for me to be laughing like that on the radio! When the Pope gave these talks, it sounded like a father was talking to his family around the dinner table.



I will miss Pope Francis. I ask you to pray for the repose of his soul, and to pray for the Cardinals who will be electing the next Pope, that they listen to the Holy Spirit and select the best man for the job.

Today this day is known to many, especially to fans of the famous movie franchise, as Star Wars Day. So today, May 4, as followers of

Jesus, how do we remember to keep holy the Sabbath and remember the importance of prayer and faith in our lives? Well, here are some quotes from the Star Wars movies that just may help us keep our focus on God and our faith.

"May the Force be with you."

Obi-Wan Kenobi taught Luke Skywalker that the Force, "surrounds us and penetrates us; it binds the galaxy together." For us, it is even better because our lives are not part of a fictional movie, they are real and we have God who is ALWAYS with us and is more than just a Force, he is an all-powerful and loving God who wants what is best for us. Prayer keeps us connected and keeps us aware that God is present. Even when we are not aware, God is always present with us.

"The Light...it's always been there. It will guide you."

Wisdom from a newer character in the franchise, Maz Kanata's words can really help us remember that the Light of Christ will guide us whenever we need it. We have a living God who loves and cares for us and we must trust in Him and let Him guide us. As Doug Bender reminds us in his article, *May the Fourth Be Prayerfully With You*, "We must trust in God to lead us on our path and protect us from the dangers of this world. When we pray, we can ask for the grace to trust in God's plan, even when we don't understand it."

"Always pass on what you have learned."

Yoda passed this wisdom onto Luke before he died. For the Jedi, it was important to share their knowledge and skills with others. We, too, are called to share what we know about our faith and the love of Jesus with others. As Doug Bender writes, "When we pray, we can ask for the courage and opportunities to be a witness to others and to share the hope and joy that comes from our relationship with God."

So as we move along on this Fourth of May, let us remember God provides many ways for us to get closer to him, even movies like "Star Wars."

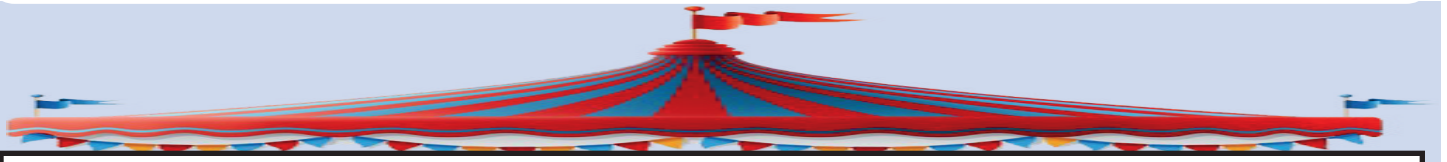
