MISSION STATEMENT

We are a Roman Catholic community united by our faith in God and nourished by Jesus through both the Word and the Eucharist. Empowered by the Holy Spirit, we strive to meet the spiritual and physical needs of our parish family and community through prayer and the ministries of the Church.

Our Lady of the Rosary in Crozet, Virginia, is currently a Catholic Mission of the Church of the Incarnation parish in Charlottesville, Virginia.

We are grateful for the official naming of our mission: Our Lady of the Rosary, by Bishop Barry Knestout, on Sunday, October 4, 2020. Bishop Knestout traveled to Crozet, where he officially renamed the existing Crozet Catholic Community to Our Lady of the Rosary in honor of the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary on October 7.

Mass is currently being celebrated on Sundays at 1:30 PM at the Crozet Baptist Church on St. George Ave. A Fellowship Gathering is held after every Mass with refreshments in the Crozet Baptist Hall. We are grateful to our brothers and sisters in faith for sharing this sacred space.

In addition, Mass is celebrated every 2nd and 4th Thursdays at the Lodge at Old Trail in Crozet at 3pm for Lodge residents. The celebrant is Father Dan Molochko. A Eucharistic service is also celebrated every **1st and 3rd Thursday at 3pm** at the Lodge. Mass is also celebrated every **3rd Wednesday at 2:30 at English Meadows** by Msgr. Keeney.

HAITI MINISTRY

Our Lady of the Rosary supports the twinning relationship of St. Thomas Aquinas and Holy Comforter with the parish of St. Michel in Saltadere, Haiti. Through prayer, visits to Haiti, and hosting the pastor of St. Michel for visits with us, the Haiti Ministry acknowledges our common bond as children of God. We raise funds in support of the parish school, St. Michel clinic, clean water access, and microloans.

Activities to raise funds include the after-Mass sale of Haitian coffee and notecards; student sponsorship; and a Haitian craft fair (Advent). Past projects have included a dinner auction and a golf tournament. The Haiti Ministry meetings are held every two months. Yearly visits to our Haiti twin parish are a personal choice and are self-funded.

MUSIC/CHOIR/SOUND CREW/LIVE STREAM

The goal of this ministry is to enhance our parish worship experience. We lead the congregation in praise and provide an avenue for parishioners to share their gifts and be a member of a tight-knit team. We practice twice a week: one time during the week and one hour immediately prior to Sunday Mass. Additional responsibilities include setting up and taking down associated music equipment before and after each service. The choir is always looking for interested singers and other instrumentalists to join the group! Practice is held at 7PM on Tuesdays at Crozet Baptist Church. The Sound Crew/Live Stream Team is a great opportunity for high school youth to become involved in helping with the liturgy!

OFFICE SUPPORT MINISTRY

Office Support is usually on an as-needed basis. Examples include:

- Mailings to parishioners (e.g., Christmas cards, tax donation reports, letters from the Pastor)
- Photocopying
- Entering new parishioner registrations into ParishSoft Family Suite system
- Sacramental records for weddings, funerals and baptisms (entry into parish registers and ParishSoft Family Suite and mailing notification letters to baptismal parishes)
- Transcribe committee and staff meeting minutes from Zoom recordings
- Any other tasks assigned by the Pastor, Parochial Vicar or Office Administrator

There are also some ongoing tasks that a volunteer could help with on a weekly basis. This would require a commitment of a total of 3-4 hours a week in the parish office.

- Handling of office mail (photocopy checks received by mail and prepare for bank deposit)
- Manage calendar requests for use of office conference room
- Update parish calendar on website
- Upload parishioner photos to ParishSoft Family Suite for parish directory
- Assist with preparation of weekly bulletin (upcoming software upgrade will allow this to be done from a home computer)
- Any other tasks assigned by the Pastor, Parochial Vicar or Office Administrator
