Never let good enough be good enough. That's the message of the gospel today. Jesus challenges us to set the bar high and not just settle for anything less. This is Jesus' call for discipleship. In today's gospel, Jesus rebukes the scribes and the Pharisees because they settle only for the minimum requirement of the law. God did not empower us to be lame; He empowered us to do much more than merely getting by. You know the one thing that differentiates the word settler from the word setter? It is the letter "L". Take out the letter "L" from the word settler, and the word transforms into setter. "L" stands for lame. As

Christians we are not settlers, but setters. We do ordinary things extraordinarily well. We go beyond the minimum. We are called to love and love is the fulfillment of the maximum demands of the law.

I invite you to not just settle for fulfilling your Sunday obligations to go to Mass. Learn more about the Eucharist. Dr. John Bergsma will provide great insights and lead a discussion on Lent and the Eucharist on Saturday, February 18th, from 9:45 am to 11:45 am in the Church. Dr. Bergsma is a close collaborator of Dr. Scott Hahn who speaks regularly on Catholic radio and at conferences and parishes nationally and internationally. He has authored over a dozen books on Scripture and the Catholic faith. Take advantage of this free event.

OUR FASCINATING FAITH

The Seven Holy Founders of the Servite Order

On February 17 we honor the seven founding saints of the Order of the Servants of the Virgin Mary. Bonfilius, Alexis, Manettus, Amideus, Hugh, Sostene and Buonagiunta were a group of merchants of Florence who, upon experiencing an apparition of the Blessed Virgin in 1233, renounced their businesses, left what was necessary for their families, and distributed the rest among the poor. They then dedicated themselves entirely to the veneration of the Virgin Mary, going to live on an Italian mountain, each assuming the life of a hermit—prayer, extreme fasting and penance. Sometime later, at the request of the pope's delegate, all but one were ordained priests. Brother Alexis, considering himself unworthy of the priesthood, decided to remain as a brother. They were all canonized in 1888. Their feast day, originally February 11, now falls on the 17th, the date of the death of the last of the seven founders. Brother Alexis died at the age of 110.
