FROM THE PASTOR

Can you remember Newton's three laws of motion? The first law states that if a body is at rest or moving at a constant speed in a straight line, it will remain at rest or keep moving in a straight line at constant speed unless it is acted upon by a force. The second law states that the time rate of change of the momentum of a body is equal in both magnitude and direction to the force imposed on it. A force applied to a body can change the magnitude of the momentum or its direction or both. The third law is the law of action and reaction. When two bodies interact, they apply forces to one another that are equal in magnitude and opposite in direction. On Christmas, there is a profound movement that is happening. The force that acted upon the Word becoming flesh is the force of love. For God so loved the world that He gave His only son that whoever believes in him should not perish but have everlasting life (John 3:16). This force is constant so that the direction that it proceeds remains the same—He is continually coming down in order that He can be near the one whom He serves and loves. His direction is constant toward service. Service is not possible when one refuses to come down from one's level and be near to the person whom one serves. Without changing his direction and momentum, God is interacting with us in His love through service, and if we humbled ourselves and embraced His love, we would find ourselves not reacting to His love but responding to it by loving and serving others. May the love of God for us be the force to bring us to constant motion of coming down and coming near to serve.


