This is a great opportunity to get to know your fellow parishioners and have fun serving your parish. All parishioners are encouraged to participate, especially the new members. Volunteers get a free dinner. We need a lot of new volunteers this year, so please volunteer to help your parish at this important parish social event and fundraiser. Volunteers are needed throughout the day; from early morning, during the dinners, and afterward for help cleaning up. Most of the population there live with well water and they have been greatly affected by the train derailment and chemical fire that entered their water ways. We are taking collections March 4th and March 5th, only until NOON.

ASH WEDNESDAY, GOOD FRIDAY and All Fridays of Lent are days of **ABSTINENCE from meat** for all persons 14 years of age and older. We are asked to abstain from meat on these days in penitential self-denial and in solidarity with, and in service to, the hungry of the world.

DISBENSATION FOR SAINT PATRICK'S DAY: The obligation to abstain from meat on the Fridays of Lent is an important element of the Churches observance of the penitential nature of this holy season. This year, March 17, the Friday of the Third Week of Lent, corresponds with St. Patrick's Day, traditionally an occasion for joy-filled celebrations in this diocese, especially among those of Irish heritage. Bishop Fernandes, taking into consideration both past practice and present circumstances, has granted to the faithful of the Diocese of Columbus, as well as to any visitors or travelers who may be physically present within the territory of this diocese a dispensation from the obligation of abstinence from meat on March 17, 2024, provided that the member of the faithful taking advantage of this dispensation, undertakes on of the following works: 1) makes a pilgrimage or visit to any church in the Diocese of Columbus named in honor of St. Patrick (Columbus, London, Junction City); 2) assists as Mass at any church chapel or oratory on March 17th; 3) prays the "Breastplate of St. Patrick," attributed to St. Patrick; 4) engages in some pious devotion such as the Rosary, the Stations of the Cross, or Eucharistic Adoration; or 5) performs an act of comparable penance (such as abstinence from meat on some other occasion during the Third Week of Lent).

Every Thursday in Lent, Stations of the Cross will be prayed beginning at **7:00 p.m.**, followed by **sung Evening Prayer** (**Vespers**) and **Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament**. This concludes Adoration. **Please note that none of these are done on Holy Thursday**.

Lenten Parish Communal Penance Service: Monday, March 27th, 7:00 p.m. in church. This is our opportunity **for ALL of us to gather** and celebrate the sacrament of Penance (or Confession) as a parish family. Please come and join us for this!!!

Individual Confession Schedule: Every Saturday of Lent (except Holy Saturday) from 3:00 p.m. until 3:30 p.m., and on every Thursdays at 9:30 a.m. (except Holy Thursday). On Monday, April 3rd, confessions will be heard from 5:00 p.m. until 6:30 p.m. in the church, which will be the final opportunity before Easter.


