MISSIONARY APPEAL: NEXT weekend August 12-13, we welcome Fr. David Adiletta, O.P. at all Masses. Fr. David will share information about the good works of the Dominican Friars Province of St. Joseph. The friars preach the Word of God and are engaged in evangelization, while working with the poor in underserved areas of Kenya. VOTING THIS TUESDAY - August 8: This Tuesday, August 8, there is a special election in the State of Ohio. "Issue 1." Issue 1 is a proposal that, if passed, would require that proposed amendments to the Ohio Constitution would require approval by 60% of those voting in order to pass. The current requirement is a simple majority (50% plus one vote). Because Issue 1 is not a moral issue, the Bishops of Ohio have remained neutral on the Issue other than to urge all Catholics to fulfill their responsibility of faithful citizenship and vote their conscience. In considering how you will vote, something to think about is the effect that the outcome of Issue 1 will have on the November election. There is a proposed constitutional amendment on the November ballot that, if passed, would enshrine abortion rights in the Ohio Constitution. As you already know, Ohio Bishops have called upon all Catholics to pray and work to defeat this proposed amendment which, if passed, would endanger the lives of preborn and diminish parental rights. As Catholics, we are obliged to do all we can to defeat this proposal. Something to consider is this: If Issue 1 passes in August, it will be more difficult for the proposed constitution amendment to enshrine abortion rights to pass in November. Please vote on August 8. And let us continue to pray and work to defeat the proposed rights amendment in November.
