Have a Blessed and Safe New Year

A REQUEST FROM OUR BISHOP

Our Bishop, **Bishop Earl Fernandes**, wrote a letter on **December 7**, **2023** to all Catholics in the Diocese of Columbus concerning respect for life – especially for the unborn – after the passing of Issue #1 which enshrined abortion rights into Ohio's state constitution. He invites all of us to intensify our prayers and practices to protect innocent life at all stages of development by calling for deeper conversion of heart to build a true culture of life here in Ohio.

He invites all of us to a deeper life of prayer, fasting and almsgiving to accomplish this goal. He invites all of us to join in a Holy Hour before Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament every week. As you know, here in our parish, we have this opportunity every Thursday with Exposition of the Eucharist from the 9:00 a.m. Mass until noon. Also on the third Thursday of each month we have another Holy Hour from 7:00-8:00 p.m. Please join us. Also, he invites us to a deeper sense of fasting and abstinence for this cause. He asks each of us to return to the traditional practice of not eating meat on all Fridays throughout the year; and to offer this penitential practice every Friday for the intention of a greater respect for all human life – especially the unborn. Abstinence can be a powerful prayer before the Lord. Along with this practice, he is encouraging almsgiving to an organization that supports the true culture of life, such as Women's Care Center, Pregnancy Decision Health Centers, Birthright, Bottoms Up or the like.

I also invite you as parishioners here at St. Margaret of Cortona Parish to strongly consider these invitations from our Bishop as the means for a deeper conversion for all of us here in the State of Ohio on this essential issue. Sincerely in Christ, **Fr. Jeff**


