ASH WEDNESDAY IS FEBRUARY 14: The date of Ash Wednesday is determined by the date on which Easter Sunday falls each year. Easter falls on the first Sunday after the first Full Moon, after the Vernal Equinox (the first day of spring). This year, Easter falls on March 31. The earliest date on which Easter can fall is March 22. The latest date on which Easter can fall is April 25. It is a day of both Fast and Abstinence.

ASH WEDNESDAY COLLECTION: Half of the proceeds of Ash Wednesday collection will be contributed to J.O.I.N. (Organization for Inner-city needs). J.O.I.N. is a diocesan agency that provides emergency assistance to the poor in the form of food, food certificates, clothing, and prescription assistance, utility help, infant formula, eyeglasses, bus transportation, ensure for seniors, car repair, burial assistance and referrals to other public and private service providers. The other half of the money will go to the St. Margaret of Cortona, St. Vincent de Paul Conference. Please be generous.

SEMINARIAN COLLECTION: This past year, our diocese went from about 20 seminarians up to 36 seminarians studying to be priests for our diocese. This is great news!! We will ordain five young men to the priesthood this May. BUT, educating seminarians is expensive. Each seminarian studies for usually 6, 8 or 9 years after high school to become a priest. Each year of their education, the diocese spends almost \$55,000,00. This adds up! Yes, the Appeal, helps out, but more money is needed. Therefore, the diocese has launched an additional campaign – "A Good and Growing Need" to assist with these costs. All parishes in our diocese will have a special second collection at all Masses on February 24-25 of this year. Please help support this necessary cause. Thank you. – Fr. Jeff
