ANOINTING OF THE SICK: We have received a letter from Bishop Fernandes regarding the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. This Sacrament is for those who have reached the age of reason who are in danger of death whether as a result of illness or old age. Those who lack a serious illness that places them in danger of death or the beginning of the danger of death. Some types of mental sickness are now classified as serious. This Sacrament may not be administered broadly to all attending Mass. While it is permissible to celebrate the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick within Mass, these Masses are not to be referred to as so-called "healing Masses." Priests are to ensure that those to be anointed have the opportunity to have their sins absolved in the Sacrament of Penance first. Only those whose health is seriously impaired by sickness or old age are proper subjects of the Sacrament. An individual may be anointed more than once, even for the same severe illness, as happens when the illness worsens or on account of the dibilitations and further weakening of old age. We will celebrate this Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick with these stipulation all in mind during the Masses here on Saturday April 6th and Sunday April 7th.
