THE APPEAL 2024: This weekend, May 4th and 5th, is Commitment Weekend for the 2024 Appeal and you are asked to make a gift to help our Catholic Ministries. You should have received your letter and Appeal envelope from Fr. Jeff, and many have received a brochure and ltter from Bishop Earl Fernandes asking for your support. This year's Appeal Theme, "Respond to His Love," encourages us to move forward in the Light of Christ, becoming ever more dependent on our Lord who is with us always. The Diocesan goal is \$7.5 million, and our parish has been asked to raise \$62,330.00. As your Pastor, I believe that this is an attainable goal, and I know that if each and every family participates through a sacrificial gift, we will do our fair share to help our diocesan family. I know there are many obligations facing us and our families. I only ask that you prayerfully consider your gift knowing no gift is too large or too small. I also hope that we exceed our goal which will enable us to use our rebated funds for our own special projects. These projects here at St. Margaret are: 1) filling in the cracks in the blacktop driveways and parking lots; 2) improving our security systems; 3) preparing another classroom for our pre-school, and 4) some maintenance items on our facilities as they age.
