JOIN BISHOPS Thomas, Fernandes, Malesic and Woost on August 14, for a Statewide Eucharistic Pilgrimage in Carey, Ohio: To mark this year of going out on mission during the National Eucharistic Revival, the Catholic Bishops of Ohio invite all the faithful to make a pilgrimage to the Basilica & National Shrine of Our Lady of Consolation in Carey on Wednesday, August 14, to celebrate the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. PLENARY INDULGENCES: A plenary indulgence is available for any of the Christian faithful participating in the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage between May 17-July 16, 2024. The elderly, infirm, or those who cannot leave their homes for a serious reason, and who participate in spirit with the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage, uniting their prayers, pains, or inconveniences with Christ and the pilgrimage, may also receive the indulgence. The conditions for receiving the indulgence include all of the following: participating in the pilgrimage, making a sacramental Confession and receiving Holy Communion in the days leading up to or just after the pilgrimage participation, and praying for the intentions of the Holy Father. The indulgence may be applied to the souls in Purgatory.

Please join us following the 10:30 a.m. Mass on Sunday, July 28, for the Annual Festival Procession of faith and thanksgiving as we carry the statues of our patron saints through the neighborhood.

This long-standing tradition of prayer and singing was brought here by the original founders of our parish. It was considered an honor to carry the statues. Various families took the responsibility of carrying their patron saint. Today, many of those families have passed on, but we have been blessed to have a parish that has grown beyond the borders of Trabue Road, McKinley Avenue and Hague Avenue. It takes many strong shoulders to make this journey. We ask that the men of our parish, 18 and over, who are physically able to please step up and fill the shoes of our ancestors and continue this most-special tradition to carry our patron saints in celebration of the blessings provided to each of us and to our parish. We also ask the women and children to walk along, pray, and sing as well.

Our route this year will be simplified. We will walk to Cortona Woods, through the neighborhood, and back to Kulp Hall where the procession will end and our Knights of Columbus will again graciously provide ice cream for all in air-conditioned comfort.


Please plan to attend and participate in this public display of our faith and thanksgiving to God for His multitude of blessings.
