PARISH MISSION: This year we journey through the Gospel of St. Luke as pilgrims with Jesus on the road to our own renewal and embracing Pope Francis' call to be Pilgrims of Hope in this Jubilee year. Beginning on the weekend of **March 29-30**, you are invited to join our parish mission to explore the themes of mercy and hope. We begin with our weekend Liturgies where we read Luke's well known parable of the Prodigal Son. ALL FRIDAYS OF LENT are days of **ABSTINENCE from meat** for all persons 14 years of age and older. We are asked to abstain from meat on these days in penitential self-denial and in solidarity with, and in service to, the hungry of the world.


