That I may praise Thee with Thy saints
and with Thy angels
Forever and ever
Amen

Act of Contrition

O my God, I am heartily sorry for having offended Thee,
and I detest all my sins because I dread the loss of Heaven and the pains of hell,
but most of all because they offend Thee, my God,
who art all good and deserving of all my love.
I firmly resolve with the help of Thy grace,





Children: **We promise to say our prayers every day. We promise to come to Holy Mass every week. We promise to try to learn and love and grow as children of God.**
