CALL TO ACTION!!:

April 29, the NYS Assembly passed a bill to legalize assisted suicide in NYS. This measure is the antithesis of accompaniment. The bill allows anyone 18 and older with a diagnosis of a terminal illness within 6 months to be prescribed life ending drugs. The bill has several dangerous components:

- There is no mandated mental health examination required
- There is no mechanism through which problems or abuses can be reported
- There is no requirement to list the cause of death as suicide

This bill is extremely dangerous to those who are disabled, the elderly, and those who lack access to insurance or are medically underserved. We have already seen in Canada and states where assisted suicide is legal, that insurance companies have denied coverage for treatments yet approved of drugs to end people's lives. The risk for coercion or abuse is great.

Our only hope at this time is to contact State Senators and let them know you oppose this bill. Our state spends millions of dollars each year to prevent suicides. What does this say to those who are ill, elderly or disabled? It tells them their lives are not worth living.

You are also encouraged to contact your state senator right away. You can send a letter electronically through the NYS Catholic Conference at nyscatholic.org. Sign up for action alerts and take action today. Even better, call your senator's office today.

Please take this issue to prayer. It truly can be a matter of life and death.


