Please know that we are a Traditional Catholic Personal Parish, and the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass is offered "ad orientem" or "facing East" - The priest, in the person of Christ, leads us to God the Father by placing our focus solely on our Lord during the Mass. The Communion Rail is used for the Latin Mass.

Please kneel (if physically able) at the Communion Rail to receive Holy Communion. Holy Communion is given only on the tongue at a Latin Mass.





Weather Blessing

Weather blessing: After low Mass on weekdays in the Summer, the traditional weather blessing is given. The priest says a prayer for protection against inclement or destructive weather and gives a blessing with the relic of the true cross.

V. From lightning strikes, hail, and violent storms. R. Deliver us, O Lord Jesus Christ. V. Show us, O Lord, Thy mercy. R. And grant us Thy salvation. V. O Lord, hear my prayer. R. And let my cry come unto Thee. V. The Lord be with you. R. And with thy spirit. Let us pray. We beseech Thee, O Almighty God, through the intercession of Holy Mary, the Mother of God, of the holy angels, patriarchs, prophets, apostles, martyrs, confessors, virgins, widows, and of all Thy saints, that Thou show us Thy continuing protection, permit tranquil winds, and also pour out to us, Thy unworthy servants, Thy safety from heaven above against lightning strikes and violent storms, and that Thou remain always protective of the human race and crush down the aerial powers by the right hand of Thy power. Through the same Christ our Lord. R. Amen May the blessing of Almighty + God Father, Son, and Holy Ghost, descend upon you, this place, and the fruits of the earth, and remain forever. Amen.





Prayer for the Pope

Whenever possible, the priests of the Institute of Christ the King Sovereign Priest add a second prayer—called a 'collect'—to the collect of the day's Mass. This is a prayer for the Holy Father. These 'Pro Papa' prayers (Collect, Secret, and Postcommunion) are from the "Mass on the Anniversary of the Election or Consecration of a Pope." They are prayed after the Collect, Secret, and Postcommunion for the day and after any additional Collect, Secret, and Postcommunion that may be prayed for a commemoration on that day. They can be found in any traditional Missal.

Per Dominum nostrum Jesum Christum, Filium tuum: qui tecum vivit et regnat in unitate Spiritus Sancti Deus, per omnia saecula saeculorum.


