
*Please kneel (if physically able) at the Communion Rail to receive Holy Communion. Holy Communion is given only on the tongue at a Latin Mass.*



## **Prayer for the Pope**

*Whenever possible, the priests of the Institute of Christ the King Sovereign Priest add a second prayer—called a 'collect'—to the collect of the day's Mass. This is a prayer for the Holy Father. These 'Pro Papa' prayers (Collect, Secret, and Postcommunion) are from the "Mass on the Anniversary of the Election or Consecration of a Pope." They are prayed after the Collect, Secret, and Postcommunion for the day and after any additional Collect, Secret, and Postcommunion that may be prayed for a commemoration on that day. They can be found in any traditional Missal.*

### **COLLECT**

Through our Lord Jesus Christ, thy Son Who liveth and reigneth with thee, in the unity of the Holy Ghost, God, world without end.
