The Communion Rail is used for the Latin Mass. Please kneel (if physically able) at the Communion Rail to receive Holy Communion. Holy Communion is given only on the tongue at a Latin Mass.



It is a dogma of the Catholic Church that the souls detained in Purgatory (the Church Suffering) can be assisted by the suffrages of the living faithful (the members of the Church Militant). These suffrages (intercessory prayers, indulgences, alms and other pious works, and above all the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass) remit before God some degree of the temporal punishments due to their sins which the poor souls still have to render.¹ So important is the undertaking of these suffrages that the Church has listed it as part of one of the Spiritual Works of Mercy, namely, "to pray for the living and the dead."


**The Public is invited to Trinity

Prayer for the Pope

Whenever possible, the priests of the Institute of Christ the King Sovereign Priest add a second prayer—called a 'collect'—to the collect of the day's Mass. This is a prayer for the Holy Father These 'Pro Papa' prayers (Collect, Secret, and Postcommunion) are from the "Mass on the Anniversary of the Election or Consecration of a Pope." They are prayed after the Collect, Secret, and Postcommunion for the day and after any additional Collect, Secret, and Postcommunion that may be prayed for a commemoration on that day. They can be found in any traditional Missal.




