The Chaplet of St. Gertrude is a devotional prayer that offers the Precious Blood of Jesus Christ for the souls in Purgatory, sinners, and the Church. It includes prayers to the Sacred Heart of Jesus for the conversion of sinners, invokes the intercession of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, and concludes with the Glory Be. This powerful chaplet reflects St. Gertrude's deep concern for the souls in Purgatory and the conversion of sinners.



## St. Gertrude Chaplet

for the Release of 50,000 Souls from Purgatory

[This chaplet is prayed using regular Rosary beads]

On the Cross, pray the "Apostle's Creed":

*I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Creator of Heaven and earth; and in Jesus Christ, His only Son Our Lord, Who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended into Hell; the third day He rose again from the dead; He ascended into Heaven, and sits at the right hand of God, the Father almighty; from thence He shall come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body and life everlasting. Amen.*

Then pray 1 "Our Father", 3 "Hail Marys" and 1 "Glory be":

Continue to the five decades. For each of the following five decades:

Pray the "Our Father" on the large bead.

On each of the 10 small beads, pray:

*Eternal Father, I offer Thee the Most Precious Blood of Thy Divine Son, Jesus, in union with the Masses said throughout the world today, for all the holy souls in Purgatory, for sinners everywhere, for sinners in the universal Church, those in my own home, and within my family. Amen.*

Conclude each decade with the following three prayers:

1. Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, open the hearts and minds of sinners to the truth and light of God, the Father.
2. Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for the conversion of sinners and the world.
3. Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit. As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.




**Prayer for Souls

### **Prayer for the Pope**

*Whenever possible, the priests of the Institute of Christ the King Sovereign Priest add a second prayer—called a 'collect'—to the collect of the day's Mass. This is a prayer for the Holy Father These 'Pro Papa' prayers (Collect, Secret, and Postcommunion) are from the "Mass on the Anniversary of the Election or Consecration of a Pope." They are prayed after the Collect, Secret, and Postcommunion for the day and after any additional Collect, Secret, and Postcommunion that may be prayed for a commemoration on that day. They can be found in any traditional Missal.*
