Happening at the Shrine

On Monday, January 5th at 5:00 p.m. we will have the solemn blessing of Epiphany Water. This is a special water that can only be blessed once a year. **Please bring containers filled with water to be blessed! Only a limited amount will be available after the 5th.**

Filled water containers can be dropped off in front of the communion rail from after the 7:30 a.m. Latin Mass until 5:00 p.m. **Please mark your containers to avoid confusing them with someone else's.**

On Tuesday, January 6th at 6:00 p.m., a High Mass will be celebrated for the Feast of the Epiphany of the Lord (Feast of the Three Kings).

The "Tuesdays Together" gathering will take place after the 12:10 p.m. English Mass.

Wednesday, January 7th: Faith formation classes resume today. Children and youth classes at start 6:15 p.m., adult class starts at 7:00 p.m.

Unity Acres Drive



We welcome you today to Saint Mary's!

If this is your first time here, we look forward to meeting you. If you are interested in registering as a parishioner, forms are available in the gift shop. You can also sign up on our website.

Saint Mary's is a shrine for Marian devotion in the Diocese of Syracuse, and a center for the celebration of Holy Mass and the sacraments in the traditional Latin Rite. This form of worship, which developed many centuries ago, is a priceless treasure of our Catholic faith. On Sundays and feast days, there are handouts containing English translations of the Propers (the prayers and readings proper to the day). If you are unfamiliar with the traditional Latin Mass, please do not hesitate to approach the clergy of the Shrine with any questions you may have. The pastoral care of the Shrine has been entrusted by the Bishop of Syracuse to the clergy of the Institute of Christ the King, a Catholic priestly society founded in 1990 and currently ministering in dioceses across the United States, Europe and Africa.

Holy communion may be received by practicing Catholics in the state of grace. Holy communion is received kneeling at the communion rail (unless you are impaired from doing so) and directly on the tongue. The sacrament of confession is available every day 30 minutes before the start of Mass (ending approximately 7 minutes before Mass begins).

In addition to the sacred liturgy and various devotions, Saint Mary's offers regular faith formation (catechism) for both children and adults. If you are not a Catholic, you are warmly invited to learn more about our faith. The Catholic Church was founded 2000 years ago by Our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ to carry on His work for the salvation of souls. If you are interested in becoming Catholic or simply want to learn more about the Catholic faith, please do not hesitate to contact us. The Shrine offers group classes and individual instruction. We look forward to hearing from you.
