"I think that Latin Mass is beautiful, but I just can't follow what's happening." "When do I sit and stand?" "How do you use a hand missal?" "I don't speak Latin. How can I ever understand this Mass?" Many of our parishioners have asked these and other questions, and expressed interest in learning more about the Latin Mass.

In a series of talks, Canon Gardner will explain the ceremonies and spirituality of the traditional Latin Mass with special emphasis on the practical question of how to follow along and fully participate.

Whether you are very familiar with the Latin Mass or just starting to learn about it, these talks will have something for you. All are welcome!

## We welcome you today to Saint Mary's!

Saint Mary's is a shrine for Marian devotion in the Diocese of Syracuse, and a center for the celebration of Holy Mass and the sacraments in the traditional Latin Rite. This form of worship, which developed many centuries ago, is a priceless treasure of our Catholic faith. On Sundays and feast days, there are handouts containing English translations of the Propers (the prayers and readings proper to the day). If you are unfamiliar with the traditional Latin Mass, please do not hesitate to approach the clergy of the Shrine with any questions you may have. The pastoral care of the Shrine has been entrusted by the Bishop of Syracuse to the clergy of the Institute of Christ the King, a Catholic priestly society founded in 1990 and currently ministering in dioceses across the United States, Europe and Africa.

Holy communion may be received by practicing Catholics in the state of grace. Holy communion is received kneeling at the communion rail (unless you are impaired from doing so) and directly on the tongue. The sacrament of confession is available every day 30 minutes before the start of all Latin Masses (ending approximately 7 minutes before Mass begins).

In addition to the sacred liturgy and various devotions, Saint Mary's offers regular faith formation (catechism) for both children and adults. If you are not a Catholic, you are warmly invited to learn more about our faith. The Catholic Church was founded 2000 years ago by Our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ to carry on His work for the salvation of souls. If you are interested in becoming Catholic or simply want to learn more about the Catholic faith, please do not hesitate to contact us. The Shrine offers group classes and individual instruction.
